- DE **Myles Garrett** recorded one sack and one forced fumble. Garrett's six sacks this season are second in the NFL and are the most by a Brown through the first three weeks of a season.

- QB **Baker Mayfield** threw for 195 yards with one touchdown. Mayfield has thrown at least one touchdown pass in each of his 16 career starts, trailing only St. Louis' Kurt Warner (23 from 1999-00) for the most consecutive starts with a touchdown pass to begin an NFL career. Mayfield's streak of at least one touchdown pass in 16 consecutive games is the fourth-longest in Browns history.

- RB **Nick Chubb** led the Browns with 96 rushing yards and added 35 receiving yards on four receptions. It marked his sixth career game with 100-plus scrimmage yards.
- TE **Demetrius Harris** recorded a 2-yard touchdown catch. It was his first touchdown this season and seventh of his career.
- DT **Larry Ogunjobi** recorded his second sack of the season. He has 8.5 in his career.
- S **Juston Burris**, who joined the Browns on Friday via waivers, recorded his third career interception.
- CB **T.J. Carrie** recorded his first interception of the season. He has five in his career.
- Rookie K **Austin Siebert** connected on field goals of 23 and 35 yards. For the season, he is 5 for 5 on field goals and 4 for 5 on PATs.
- Rookie P **Jamie Gillan** had three punts downed inside the 20-yard line. He has 11 on the season.
