NOTABLE STORYLINES

• The Browns (3-1) return to FirstEnergy Stadium this Sunday, Oct. 11 at 4:25 p.m. ET to take on the Indianapolis Colts (3-1) of the AFC South. Cleveland looks to win four consecutive games for the first time since the 2009 season and defeat Indianapolis for the first time since 2011 (Week 2) and the first time at home since 1988 (Week 3).

• In Week 4, the Browns continued to run with purpose, leaving Dallas with a 49-38 victory on the back of 307 rushing yards, the most by the team since 2009. The win also propelled the Browns to 3-1 for the first time since 2001. The team's 49 points and six total touchdowns were its most since 2007 and its 33 first downs were its most since 1954.

• After the exit of RB **Nick Chubb** early in the second quarter with a knee injury, the Browns' depth rallied around RBs **Kareem Hunt, D'Ernest Johnson** and **Dontrell Hilliard**, who helped power the team to 24 unanswered points in the second quarter alone. Johnson led the way with 95 yards, Hunt added 71 yards and two touchdowns and Hilliard had 19 on the day.

• Then, there was WR **Odell Beckham Jr.**, who had a long run in the first half and the big one in the end to finish with 73 of his own yards on the ground. Beckham Jr.'s 50-yard rushing score, which helped add to the Browns' total at the end of the fourth quarter, was the first of his career and the longest by a non-running back in Browns history.

•The contest was one of Beckham Jr.'s most prolific performances as a Brown, adding five receptions for 81 receiving yards and two touchdowns to his rushing totals. He tied his career high with three total touchdowns in the game and became the fourth NFL receiver with at least two receiving touchdowns and a rushing touchdown in a single game since 2000.

• Beckham Jr. received his 50th career touchdown pass from WR Jarvis Landry in the game, 37 yards for the longest recorded touchdown pass by a receiver in Browns history. Landry, who appeared in his 100th career game, extended his streak of two receptions to 99 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the NFL and the fifth longest streak in NFL history.

• DE **Myles Garrett** continued to wreak havoc on opposing offenses, posting his third strip-sack in as many games and two total sacks on the day. Only Reggie White (52), Aldon Smith (42), Shawne Merriman (38.5) and Derrick Thomas (38.5) had more sacks through their first 41 games in the NFL (tied Anthony Smith).

• The Browns recorded three takeaways for the second straight game last week, the only such streak that's active in the league. The Browns lead the NFL with 10 takeaways this year (four interceptions and six fumble recoveries) and with a +6 turnover differential.

KEVIN Stefanski FRANK Reich

KEVIN STEFANSKI: 3-1, FIRST SEASON AS A HEAD COACH. FIRST WITH THE BROWNS.

On January 13, 2020, the Cleveland Browns announced the hiring of Kevin Stefanski as the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history. The 38-year old spent the past 14 seasons in various roles with the Minnesota Vikings. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach and elevated up the coaching ladder, serving as assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanki played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania.

FRANK REICH: 21-17, 3RD SEASON AS A HEAD COACH, 3RD WITH THE INDIANAPOLIS

COLTS. The Indianapolis Colts appointed Frank Reich as head coach of the franchise on February 11, 2018 after serving seven years as the team's wide receivers coach (2011-17). Reich has been in the NFL since 2008 under different offensive roles, including offensive coordinator, wide receivers and QB coach between four organizations from 2008-2017. Reich helped the Colts become the third team in NFL history make the playoffs following a 1-5 start in 2018, along with their first postseason appearance since 2014. He played 13 NFL seasons for Buffalo (1985-94), Carolina (1995), Detroit (1997-98), and New York Jets (1996), also winning Super Bowl LII as the offensive coordinator for the Philadelphia Eagles.



TEAM

- With a win, look to improve to 4-1 for the first time since 1994.
- With a win, will have won four consecutive wins for the first time since 1994.

QB BAKER MAYFIELD

- One completion away from 700 in his career.
- Four passing touchdowns away from 60 in his career.
- Is 184 yards away from passing Bernie Kosar for most passing yards by a Brown in thier first three seasons.

DE MYLES GARRETT

- Making his 40th career start.
- One forced fumble from having the most by a Brown since 2000.

WR JARVIS LANDRY

- He and teammate WR Odell Beckham Jr. look to extend their active streaks to 100 and 80 consecutive games with at least a pair of receptions, respectively. All time, Landry's streak of 99 games ranks sixth.
- With four receptions, will tie for 10th in receptions for a player in their first seven seasons in history (585).

DT SHELDON RICHARDSON

- One forced fumble away from 10 in his career.

BILL WILLIS COACHING FELLOWSHIP

The Browns created the Bill Willis Coaching Fellowship in 2020, which is intended for a rising minority coach with a focus on the offensive side of the ball. In the program, the coach spends a full season with Cleveland's coaching staff and assist coaches with week-to-week game plans and talent evaluations. The fellowship also provides the coach with a plethora of resources to network with other coaches, gain valuable knowledge on the implementation of NFL-level coaching methods and improve their path to a professional coaching career.


The team created the fellowship to provide opportunities and experience to minority coaches, who have historically faced barriers in their pursuit of entry-level positions and promotions. The fellowship was named after Willis, who along with teammate Marion Motley, overcame many obstacles to become two of the first African-American professional football players in the modern era. Willis played with the Browns from 1946-53 and was enshrined into the Pro Football Hall of Fame in 1977.

Ashton Grant was named the first-ever recipient of the Bill Willis Coaching Fellowship on July 14, 2020.

Utth The Browns currently rank fourth in the NFL with a 31.0 points-per-game average, the highest in team history. The

- points-per-game average, the **highest in team history**. The total is the **best in the AFC this year**.
- The team's 204.5 rushing yards per game are the most in the NFL, with the no other team totaling above 180.0 this season. The mark is also the second-highest tally by a Browns team in history. The mark is the most by any NFL team through four weeks since the Atlanta Falcons in 2006 (234.3).
- The team is **first in rushing touchdowns** with eight. The total ties for **fourth by a Browns team** through the first four weeks of a season.
- The Browns are first in team rushing average with 5.88. The average is currently the highest by any team since 1932, eclipsing the 1963 Browns team in second place on the list (5.74).
- The Browns are also first in rushing yards with 818, the only team with at least 800 rushing yards this year. The total is the third most by a Browns team through the first four weeks of a season.
- The team is **tied for fourth in the NFL** with 12 red zone touchdowns this season, **second in the AFC**.
- The Browns scored a touchdown 80 percent of the time they entered the red zone this season (12 of 15), tied for the second best percentage in the NFL and is the best in the AFC.
- The Browns' 387.0 total net yards per game are the most by a Browns team in history.
- The Browns are tied for second in the NFL with 42 rushing first downs. The total is the most by a Browns team through the first four weeks of a season since 1991. The mark also ties for eighth among all NFL teams through four weeks since 1991.
- The Browns' 33.3 first-down percentage is the **most by the team since 1963**.
- The offense's 396.0 scrimmage yards per game are the **most in team history**.
- With 124 total points this year, the Browns are third in the NFL and first in the AFC. The total is the third most by a Browns team through the first four weeks of a season.

- The Browns are **tied for second in the NFL** and **tied for first in the AFC** with 16 scrimmage touchdowns in 2020. The total is the **third most by a Browns team** through the first four weeks of a season.
- The team's 1,584 total scrimmage yards are 10th in the NFL and fifth in the AFC. The total is the seventh most by a Browns team through the first four weeks of a season.
- The club's 95 total first downs are the **most by a Browns team** through four weeks since 1991.



With 49 points last week and 35 points and 34 points in Weeks 2 and 3, respectively, the Browns have scored at least **30 points in three consecutive games for the first time since 1968** (seven games, Weeks 6-12).




The Browns currently rank **first in the NFL with a 6+ turnover differential**. The team has posted 10 takeaways (four interceptions and six fumble recoveries), while giving up just two interceptions and two fumbles. The Browns are **undefeated** this season when they don't lose the turnover differential.


TEAM NOTES



- The Browns have improved to 3-1 for the first time since 2001.
- Last week, the Browns earned their first road win since Sept. 29, 2019 and their first win in October since Oct. 7, 2018. It was also their first October road win since Oct. 11, 2015.
- Following the win over the Cowboys in Week 4, the Browns secured two wins against NFC East opponents in the same season for the first time in team history.
- The Browns have won three consecutive games for the first time since Weeks 10-12 last season. After winning three straight games from Week 14 to Week 16 in 2018, the streak marks the first time the Browns have won at least three straight games in three consecutive seasons since 2012-14.
- At 3-1, Kevin Stefanski is off to the **best start by a new Browns head coach** since Butch Davis in 2001.
- Stefanski's 3-1 record is the **best among all new head coaches** in the NFL this season.



- This season, the Browns rank **tied for fourth** in the NFL in points per game at home with a 34.5 average.
- They also rank third in the league with 186.5 rushing yards per game at home.
- The team has one giveaway at home this year, tied for the fifth-lowest total in the league in 2020.
- The Browns offense is averaging 34.2 percent of plays resulting in a first down at home, ranked eighth in the NFL.
- Since 2019, the team is averaging 132.8 rushing yards per game at home, ranked seventh in the NFL, and is averaging 134.9 rushing yards per game at home since 2018, ranked sixth.
- The team's 21 giveaways at home since 2018 are the NFL's eighth-lowest mark.
- The Browns have only been sacked 16 times at home since last year, tied for the **third-lowest mark** in the NFL.





A LOOK AT THE BROWNS' 2020 DEFENSIVE RANKINGS AROUND THE NFL

5 TAKEAWAYS (WEEK 3), MOST TAKEAWAYS IN A GAME BY A TEAM •



The Browns defense forced five turnovers (three interceptions, two fumbles) in Week 3, the most by a Browns team since recording six against Pittsburgh in 2018. The 24 points scored off those turnovers were the most scored by any team in a game this season and tied for the second most in the NFL dating back to 2018. They're also the most points scored off turnovers by a Browns team in a contest since 2000.



- The Browns offensive line didn't surrender a sack in Week 2, one of just 11 performances in the NFL through four weeks this season that hasn't allowed a sack in a given game.
- The unit's six sacks allowed on the season tie it for the **10thfewest sacks surrendered** in the NFL and are tied for the sixth fewest in the AFC.
- Its six sacks allowed are **tied for the sixth fewest** by a Browns team from Weeks 1-4 since 1991 and are the **fewest** by a Browns team since 2014 (four).

Its 21 pressures allowed rank first in the NFL.

TEAM NOTES

BROWNS NOTEBOOK



When the Browns departed Dallas following their 49-38 victory in Week 4 over the Cowboys, they left after achieving several milestones:

1. The Browns scored 31 points in the first half last week, <u>the most by the team in a single</u> <u>contest since 1991</u> and the most by a team this season.

2.) The team's f<mark>our total touchdow</mark>ns in the first half t<u>ied for the most by a Browns team</u> Through the first two quarters of a game since 2.000 and tied for the most by a team this season.

3.) The Browns' **307 rushing yard**s last week were the most by the team since week 15 at Ransas City in 2009 (351) and the most in the NFL since the Jets in week 5 of 2018 (323). The total ranks ninth in Browns history.

The 307 rushing yards were the most allowed by a Cowboys team in history.

5.) The Browns' 49 points scored were the most by the team since it scored 51 against Cincinnati in Week 2 in 2007 and the most by a team this season. <u>The total ranks tied for</u> sixth in Browns history.

6.) The team registered <mark>33 first dow</mark>ns last week, the <u>most by the team since 1954</u> and the tied for the third most by the team in history. The total is tied for the second most by a team this season.

7. The contest marked the first time the Browns had three players rush for at least 70 yards in a game (Hunt, Beckham Jr. and Johnson).

8.) The Browns had five players with a rush of at least 10 yards for the first time since 2012 (Hunt, Beckham Jr., Chubb, Johnson and Hilliard).

9. The team's six total touchdowns were the most by the Browns since week 2 in 2007 and the most by a team this year. The total ranks tied for seventh in Browns history.

10.) The Browns recorded three takeaways for the second straight game last week, the only such streak that's active in the league.

11.) The team's 508 total yards were the most by the team since last year in Week 4 and was just <u>the fifth time the team has reached the marker in a game since 1986</u> (19th overall). The 508 yards rank seventh by a team this year.

(12.) The game marked the <u>most team rushing yards without a single 100-yard rusher</u> in a game by an NFL club since the 1970 merger.

The Browns offense has 89 combined for 4.89 rushing average since 2018, the second-highest average in the NFL. The unit has also posted 1,612 rushing yards (fifth) and 38 rushing touchdowns (tied for sixth) in that span.

THE LONG The Browns have posted 81 rushes for 10-plus yards and 22 rushes for 20-plus HAUL yards since last season, both ranked second in the league. Additionally, the team's 11 carries for 20-plus yards and 30 for 10-plus yards through week 4 place first in both categories this year.

Since 2000, the 30 carries for 10-plus yards and the 11carries for 20-plus yards are both the second most by a team through the first four weeks of a season

T STOP, T STOP CAN'7

The Browns have proven to be hard to take down since 2019, posting 1,556 rushing yards after contact since last season (second in the NFL). This year, the team ranks first in the category with 506 rushing yards after contact, the second-most YAC through the first four weeks of a season by any team since 2000. The team's 506 rushing yards after contact are also 230 yards better than the next closest team at 276 (Chargers).

MAGIC

Since last year, the Browns rank tied for fifth in the NFL with a 7.9 scrimmage yards-per-touch average.

Yards per reception average, tied for eighth among all teams since 2018.

25 Receptions for 20-plus yards, seventh since 2018.

THE MORE YOU CAN DO In Week 2, Chubb Posted 133 scrimmage yards and two scrimmage touchdowns, while Hunt added 101 scrimmage yards and another pair of scrimmage touchdowns. It's the first time since the 2010 Giants in Week 13 (Brandon Jacobs and Ahmad Bradshaw) two running backs on the same team have posted 100-plus scrimmage yards and two-plus scrimmage touchdowns in a single game.



when Hunt rushed for his first touchdown of the game in the second quarter of week 4, he and Chubb became the third set of <u>RB teammates each with at least four-plus touchdowns through</u> four games in the Super Bowl era.

DE MYLES GARRETT

DE Myles Garrett notched his second consecutive multi-sack game of the season last week and added his third consecutive game with a strip-sack. Garrett currently ranks tied for first in the NFL with **five** sacks, three forced fumbles and two opponent fumble recoveries. The pair of fumble recoveries also tie Garrett for second in total takeaways. He now has 35.5 sacks in his career. the second most by an active player in 41 career games or less and is tied for the fifth most in the same amount of games in NFL history. Garrett's 35.5 career sacks passed Reggie Camp's 34 for the most by a Brown in his first four years. Garrett is currently fifth in sacks in Browns history.

Since entering the league in 2017, Garrett is sixth in the NFL with 35.5 sacks, despite playing in at least seven less games than any player in the top 10. Additionally, Garrett's 0.87 sacks per game in the same span rank third in the NFL by a player who has appeared in at least 16 games.

• Active with Open Doors Academy in Cleveland and participated in a poetry workshop with ODA kids during this year's training camp.

• In support of families that lost a loved one to police brutality, Garrett covered funeral costs for David McAtee, who was shot and killed by police in Louisville, Ky. in May.

• In his fourth year of serving on the Waterboys organization and his second as the active player captain. The foundation works to bring clean water to communities in need in East Africa. In his role as captain, Garrett leads a team of active NFL players committed to using their platform to engage their fans in the clean water crisis. Since its launch, Waterboys has funded 83 wells serving more than 350,000 people. Roughly 844 million people around the world are without basic water access – more than twice the population of the United States. In 2020, traveled to Tanzania for a two-week trip to help install wells.

Garrett's nine forced fumbles are already the most among Browns in history who have played in four seasons and are tied for the most among all Browns since 2000.

RB KAREEM HUNT

In Week 4, RB Kareem Hunt registered 11 rushes for 71 yards and two touchdowns, his first multi-touchdown rushing game since 2018 and added his 20th career rushing score. The game marked Hunt's 19th contest with 50-plus scrimmage yards and a scrimmage touchdown, and his seventh game with at least 50 scrimmage yards and two touchdowns, tied for ninth among all players in the NFL since 2017. He's also tied for fourth in the NFL with five games consisting of at least one receiving touchdown and one rushing touchdown since 2017.

WR JARVIS LANDRY

In his 100th career game last week, WR **Jarvis Landry** recorded five receptions for 48 yards and tossed his first career touchdown pass on the Browns' first drive of the game,

> a 37-yard pass to Beckham Jr. (his 50th career receiving score). The



pass was Landry's sixth attempt in his career and first touchdown. He now has 109 passing yards since 2014, third in the NFL by a WR since that time, behind WRs Mohamed Sanu (135) and Beckham Jr. (126). He's also 2-2 for 100 yards and a touchdown in his last two passing attempts. It was the first touchdown pass by a Browns WR since Mohamed Massaguoi in Week 16 of 2010

and the longest passing touchdown by a Browns WR in history. **7th** Landry is currently 11th in NFL history for receptions in a player's first seven years (581). His 581 receptions total ranks fifth in NFL history in a player's first 100 games.

6th In Week 11 last year, Landry broke DeAndre Hopkins' record for most receptions in the first six years of a player's career (528). Landry is the only player in NFL history to record at least 80 receptions and 700 receiving yards in each of his first six seasons.



5th With 481 career receptions through his fifth year, Landry broke the NFL record for most catches in the first five years of a career against the Ravens in Week 5 of 2018.

4th Landry also shattered the record for most receptions through the first four years of a career in 2017 with 400.

3rd Landry ranks second for most receptions during the first two years of a career (194).

2nd He's tied for most in the first three years of a career (288) with teammate Odell Beckham Jr.

TWO AT A TIME

Since Week 2 of his rookie season in 2014, Landry has caught at least two passes in 99 consecutive games. His streak is the best in the NFL since 2014 and is the longest that's active.



WR ODELL BECKHAM JR.

Last week's contest was one of WR Odell Beckham Jr.'s most prolific performances as a Brown, recording five catches for 81 yards and two touchdowns, along with two rushing attempts for 73 yards and his first career rushing score. His

50-yard rushing score was the longest by a non-running **back** in Browns history. He tied his career high with three total touchdowns in the game and became the **fourth NFL** receiver with at least two receiving touchdowns and a rushing touchdown in a single game since 2000. He received his 50th career touchdown pass from Landry in the game, 37 yards for the longest recorded touchdown pass by a receiver in Browns history. He also became the **first Browns** player with a 30-yard receiving touchdown and 50-yard rushing



TWO TUDDIES

With at least two receiving scores in 12 games since entering the league in 2014, Beckham Jr. ranks tied for third in the NFL in that category in an active player's first seven years. Since being drafted, he's also second to Antonio Brown's 15 games and is tied for seventh all time for most multi-touchdown games in a player's first 70 contests and is currently tied for sixth in a players first 80 games with one to play before reaching the benchmark.

Beckham Jr. has proven to be a reliable go-to WR when it counts since he entered the NFL, tying for second in the league with 20 fourth-quarter touchdown receptions, fourth in yards (2,030), fourth in 20-plus-yard receptions (32) and seventh in receptions (134).

QB BAKER MAYFIELD

QB Baker Mayfield finished Week 4 with 19 completions for 165 yards and two touchdowns. With 55 career touchdowns. he passed Eli Manning (54) for the most touchdowns by a No. 1 pick in his first three years, trailing Matthew Stafford (60), Cam Newton (64), Jared Goff (65), Jameis Winston (69). **Peyton Manning** (85) and Andrew Luck (86). Mayfield is now 184 yards back of Bernie Kosar for **most** passing yards by a **Brown** in his first three years. He's also 11 passing touchdowns back of Otto Graham for the most passing touchdowns in Browns' first three years with 56. Week 4 marked Mayfield's third consecutive game with a passer rating of 100.0 or better. tied for the second-longest active streak in the NFL. It was also his third straight game with two passing touchdowns.

TIMES TWO

Dating back to 2018, Mayfield is eighth in Browns history in games with at least two touchdown passes.

BACK-TO-BACK BAKER

After Week 4, Mayfield registered three consecutive games with a 100.0-plus passer rating and at least two passing touchdowns for the first time in his career. The Browns are 11-1 when Mayfield posts a 100.0-plus passer rating, 10-1 when he posts a 100.0-plus passer rating and a passing touchdown and 8-1 when he posts a100.0-plus passer rating and multiple passing touchdowns. The team is also 8-2 when Mayfield completes at least 69 percent of his passes.



 Passionate about the Special Olympics and Providence House and has showed his support for both through the NFL's My Cause, My Cleats platform. In 2018, he released a clothing line through Barstool Sports with 100 percent of the proceeds going to Special Olympics in the greater Cleveland area. The Providence House protects at-risk children and supports families through crisis, strengthening communities to end child abuse and neglect. TE Austin Hooper posted his first career touchdown reception as a Brown, as well as season highs in receptions (five) and receiving yards (34), last week. Hooper is in his first season with the Browns after posting his

best season in 2019, catching 75 passes for 787 yards and six touchdowns to land his second consecutive Pro Bowl invitation. The Stanford product entered the league in 2016 and since that time, Hooper has 226 receptions for 2,340 yards and 17 touchdowns. Among all tight ends in that span, his receptions rank sixth, his receiving yards a rank ninth and his receiving touchdowns rank tied for eighth. Additionally, his career long touchdown reception of 88 yards is the longest by a tight end since 2016.

Since entering the league as a rookie in 2016, Hooper has increased his receptions and receiving yards totals every year (2016: 19 rec, 271 yds; 2017: 49 rec, 526 yds; 2018: 71 rec, 660 yds; 2019: 75 rec, 787 rec yds).

RB NICK CHUBB

RB Nick Chubb didn't waste any time before he was placed on injured reserve in Week 5. Despite leaving the Browns' Week 4 contest at the start of the second quarter, Chubb entered Week 5 ranking third in the **NFL** with 335 rushing yards, tied for second in rushing touchdowns with four and fifth in rushing average with a 5.88 mark. Chubb is also 973 rushing yards back of Jim Brown for the most by a Brown in his first three years and passed Jamal Lewis for **10th on the Browns** all-time rushing list with 2,825.

Chubb has 13 100-yard rushing performances in his career and is the first Browns player to record 100 rushing yards and two rushing touchdowns in consecutive weeks (Weeks 2-3) since Leroy Kelly in 1967.

Week 3 marked the 26th game Chubb has recorded at least 50 rushing yards in a game. His 26 games are only five back of Jim Brown's 31 for most by a Brown in his first three years.

Chubb also has 27 career games of 50-plus scrimmage yards, tied for third by a Brown in his first three years.

ANYTHING BUT AVERAGE

Chubb's career 5.16 rushing average is the highest by a Brown through his first 36 games and is the fourth-highest average by a Brown in history.

BEYOND FOOTBALL

Last offseason, Chubb teamed up with VKTRY Gear to provide 500 free pairs of insoles to frontline healthcare workers.

BIG-PLAY BACK

Chubb ranks second by a Brown since 1991 in carries for 10-plus yards with 81, but has the most carries for 20-plus yards (28) in the same timeframe.

PLAYER NOTES

CB Denzel Ward has posted the **most interceptions versus the AFC North** since he was drafted in 2018 with five. His **six total takeaways also rank first**, while his **16 passes defensed place first**. His one interception returned for a touchdown is **tied for first**.



S Andrew Sendejo notched his 400th career tackle last week and has 401 for his career. He added a forced fumble on the day, his first since 2014.

S Tavierre Thomas notched five special teams tackles in the team's win over Dallas last week, the **most by any NFL player** in a game this season and tied for the most by any player since 2018. They were also the most by a Browns player since Leigh Bodden recorded five in 2004. Thomas is tied for the **NFL lead** with six special teams tackles this year.

Last week, DE **Olivier Vernon** appeared in his **115th game** and recovered his first fumble since 2018. The nine-year vet has 54.5 career sacks since 2012 and 30 against the AFC, **eighth** among all defensive ends against the AFC in that span.

DE Adrian Clayborn's career-high mark of six sacks in a single game (2017) is tied for the most ever by a player in NFL history. His two forced fumbles and fumble recovery in the same contest make him the only player in history to have six sacks, two forced fumbles and fumble recovery in the same game. His two sacks in 2020 are tied for second on the team, while his three TFLs are tied for the team lead.

> DT **Sheldon Richardson** tied a career high with **three forced fumbles in 2019**. Since he was a rookie in 2013, Richardson places **tied for fifth** among all defensive linemen with **eight forced fumbles versus the AFC**. His two sacks in 2020 are tied for second on the team, while his three TFLs are tied for the team lead. He's the only Browns defensive lineman with a pass defense this year.

Rookie TE **Harrison Bryant** caught his first career touchdown pass in Week 3, tying him for the **most receiving scores among rookie tight ends** this season. He also leads the same category with seven receptions and 59 receiving yards. Bryant won the team's 2020 Maurice Bassett Award, given annually to the franchise's most outstanding rookie in training camp as voted by local media.

S **Karl Joseph** is second on the team with 23 tackles and tied for first with one interception. Joseph's return of 49 yards ranks **third** in the NFL this season for long returns and is the **longest interception return of his career**.

> In Week 3, LB **B.J. Goodson** recorded an interception and a fumble recovery to become the first Brown with an interception and a fumble recovery in the same game since LB Christian Kirksey on Oct. 21, 2018. Goodson is **tied for seventh** among the league's linebackers in 2020 with two pass breakups, **tied for first** with one interception and **tied for first** with two total takeaways. He **leads the team** with 27 tackles.

HC KEVIN STEFANSKI

Kevin Stefanski was named the 18th full-time head coach in Cleveland Browns history on January 13, 2020. He spent the previous 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings, where he moved up the coaching ladder from assistant to the head coach to offensive coordinator.

Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach and remained with the organization under three different head coaches. After serving as assistant quarterbacks coach from 2009-13, Stefanski spent two seasons (2014-15) coaching the tight ends and one season (2016) as running backs coach. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019.

In 2019, the Vikings posted a 10-6 record and earned their first road playoff win since January 9, 2005, after defeating the Saints, 26-20, in New Orleans. Three offensive players were selected to the Pro Bowl as RB Dalvin Cook and FB C.J. Ham were each named to their first career Pro Bowl with Cook voted a starter. QB Kirk Cousins was also named to the Pro Bowl.

In his first full year under Stefanski, Cousins set a singleseason career high for passer rating with a 107.4 mark, fourth best in the NFL in 2019. Cousins also finished with a careerlow six interceptions, while adding 26 touchdowns and a 69.1 completion percentage, fourth in the NFL in 2019. He set a Vikings record for completions in a season with 425 and finished with the second-most passing yards (4,298) and passer rating (107.4) in Vikings history.

With 1,135 rushing yards, Cook became the eighth player in Vikings history to rush for 1,000 yards in a single season and the first since Adrian Peterson in 2015. Despite missing the final two games of the season, Cook finished fourth in the NFL with 13 rushing touchdowns and seventh in scrimmage yards with 1,654.

WR Stefon Diggs set a career high with 1,130 receiving yards, giving him back-to-back 1,000-receiving yard seasons for the first time in his career. Diggs finished fourth in the NFL with an average of 17.9 yards per reception in 2019.

Stefanski was elevated from quarterbacks coach to interim offensive coordinator in Week 15 of the 2018 season and promptly guided the unit to two of its best showings of the season. In his first game calling plays, Minnesota scored a season-high 41 points and recorded 418 yards of offense en route to a 41-17 victory over the Dolphins.

As quarterbacks coach in 2017, the Vikings were forced to go to their backup, Case Keenum, early in the season after starter Sam Bradford went down with an injury. Keenum, who had completed 58 percent of his passes previously owned a 9-15 career record as a starter, went on to complete nearly 68 percent of his throws with 22 touchdowns and seven interceptions while leading the Vikings to a record of 11-3.

In his lone season coaching the running backs in 2016, the Vikings battled injuries along the offensive line and to RB Adrian

Peterson that caused the runner to miss 13 games. The running game leaned on veterans Jerick McKinnon and Matt Asiata as the duo combined for 941 yards and eight rushing touchdowns.

As tight ends coach, Stefanski helped develop Pro Bowl TE Kyle Rudolph. In 2015, his unit helped clear the way for Adrian Peterson to lead the NFL in rushing with 1,485 yards.

Stefanski was elevated to assistant quarterbacks coach in 2009, where he had a hands-on role in one of the most successful offense seasons in Vikings history. Veteran QB Brett Favre signed with the team in mid-August and finished the season with 4,202 passing yards and 33 touchdowns. The Vikings finished the season 12-4 and won the NFC North.

Stefanski spent 2006-08 working directly with Head Coach Brad Childress on administrative duties and special projects. Stefanski first worked with Childress during Eagles training camp in 2005 as part of the team's operations department.

Stefanski spent the 2005 season at his alma mater, Pennsylvania, as assistant director of football operations, coordinating all aspects of the Quakers' day-to-day operations.

A team captain as a senior in 2003, Stefanski was part of one of the most successful stretches in the history of the Quaker football program. The team won three Ivy League titles (2000, 2002 and 2003), and went 10-0 in 2003 to become the first undefeated Penn team in a decade. During Stefanski's tenure, the squad posted a 42-7 overall record and a 32-3 mark in Ivy League play and he was twice honored as an Honorable Mention All-Ivy choice in 2002 and 2004.

Stefanski earned a bachelor's degree in communications from Pennsylvania and attended St. Joseph's Prep in Philadelphia.


The Stefanski family has made a name in athletics as Kevin's father, Ed, was a basketball standout at Penn and works in the front office of the Detroit Pistons. He has previously held executive positions with the NBA's New Jersey Nets, Philadelphia 76ers, Toronto Raptors and Memphis Grizzlies.

Stefanski and wife, Michelle, have a daughter and two sons.
