KEY NOTES

- Lone season at Charlotte (2020) was cut short due to COVID-19, but lead the program in rushing, posting numbers of 80 rushes for 337 yards and four touchdowns. Transferred to Charlotte as a graduate transfer after spending the previous three years at Northern Illinois.
- Finished at Northern Illinois registering back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons (2018-19). Also registered 2,345 rushing yards and 16 scores on the ground, while snagging 16 receptions for 137 yards in 35 games.
- In final season with the Huskies', tallied 1,034 rushing yards on 206 carries becoming the first 1,000-yard rusher for the program since 2015.
- Spent spring 2016 at Virginia before transferring to Northern Illinois.
