

## POSTGAME NOTES

### Cleveland Browns at Pittsburgh Steelers

#### Heinz Field | Jan. 3, 2022

#### RB Nick Chubb

- RB Nick Chubb capped the night with a team-high 12 carries for 58 yards (4.8 avg).
- Chubb ranks third in the league with 1,201 rushing yards and second in rushes of 10-plus yards with 39 this season. He also is the only player in the league with 950-or-more rushing yards in each of the past four seasons.
- Chubb notched his 47th game with 50-or-more scrimmage yards, the most by a Brown in their first 57 career games.
- Chubb has reached 50 rushing yards in 45 games since he was drafted in 2018, passing Jim Brown for most by a Brown in their first four years. The 45 is also the most amongst all Browns in their first 57 games.
- He also logged his 45th game with 50-or-more rushing yards, the third-most by an active player behind Ezekiel Elliott (49) and Adrian Peterson (48) in their first 57 games.
- The 45 games Chubb has rushed for more than 50 yards are third-most by an active player in their first four seasons.

#### TE David Njoku

- TE David Njoku hauled in his fourth touchdown catch (leads team) of the season and ended the night with four catches for 28 receiving yards.
- Njoku's 15 career touchdown catches are the third-most by a tight end in Browns history.

#### QB Baker Mayfield

- QB Baker Mayfield completed 16-of-38 passes for 185 yards, two touchdown throws and two INTs. Mayfield ranks fourth in Browns' history with 92 touchdown throws.

- Mayfield became the eighth player in NFL history with 3,000-or-more pass yards and 15-plus touchdown passes in each of their first four seasons.
- Mayfield ranks fourth in franchise history with 92 career passing touchdowns, third in career passing yards (14,125) and third in career completions (2,085).

- Mayfield's 30 games with more than two passing touchdowns are fourth in team history and is first by a Brown in his first four seasons.

### **WR Jarvis Landry**

- WR Jarvis Landry registered four receptions for 43 yards.
- Landry (682) is one of just four players to have 680-plus catches since 2014, including DeAndre Hopkins (737), Julio Jones (700) and Travis Kelce (700).

### **Other notes**

- TE Harrison Bryant scored his third touchdown of the season on a one-yard catch. He now has caught a touchdown pass in three games in a row, the first Browns tight end to do so since Gary Barnidge recorded four straight games with a touchdown in Weeks Three-Six of the 2015 season.
- DE Jadeveon Clowney logged two sacks and forced a fumble tonight, upping his season sack total to seven. This was the seventh time in Clowney's career he has registered at least two sacks in a game.
- S Grant Delpit made a game-high 11 tackles tonight, tying a career high.
- CB A.J. Green notched his first-career interception.
- CB Greg Newsome II recorded a career-high eight tackles tonight.
- WR Donovan Peoples-Jones ended tonight with three catches for a team-high 76 yards.
- DT Tommy Togiai recorded a career-high five tackles.

### **Injury report**

- LB Sione Takitaki injured his shoulder and did not return.
- CB Denzel Ward injured his groin and did not return.
- CB Greedy Williams suffered a shoulder injury in the second quarter and was ruled out.
