

POSTGAME NOTES

Cleveland Browns at Kansas City Chiefs

Arrowhead Stadium | Sept. 12, 2021

Team

- The Browns scored three touchdowns on their first three drives to begin a game since Oct. 13, 2019 versus the Seattle Seahawks.
 - This is also the first time the club accomplished the same feat on the road since Nov. 25, 2018 at Cincinnati when the Browns scored four touchdowns on the first four possessions.
- The Browns offense notched 457 offensive yards, the most by a Browns team in a season opener since the club moved back to Cleveland in 1999.
- The Browns are now 27-40-1 in season openers.

QB Baker Mayfield

- QB Baker Mayfield started his third consecutive season opener, making him the first Browns QB to start three consecutive season openers since QB Brian Sipe (1978-80).
- Mayfield ended the game with 21 completions on 28 throws for 321 yards.
- Mayfield's 321 yards was the first 300-yard performance by a Brown in a season opener since Kelly Holcomb threw for 326 yards on 18 for 30 passes against the Kansas City Chiefs on Sept. 8, 2002.

RB Nick Chubb

- RB Nick Chubb led the game with 83 yards on 15 rushes for two touchdowns.
- Chubb's two-touchdown performance tied former Browns Otto Graham and Kevin Mack for fourth most games (seven) in club history recording two-or-more rushing touchdowns.
- Chubb now has a total of 30 rushing TDs for his career.
- With his two scores on the day, Chubb now has an active streak of seven games with a rushing touchdown, tying Jim Brown for the second longest (seven) in team history.
- This was Chubb's 34th game with at least 50 rushing yards, trailing Jim Brown (41) for the most by a Brown in their first four seasons.
- Chubb now has 36 career games tallying 50-or-more scrimmage yards, matching Kevin Mack for most by a Browns player in their first 45 career games and tied for third by a Brown in their first four seasons.

DE Myles Garrett

- DE Myles Garrett made his 50th career start today.
- Garrett now has 14.5 sacks in the month of September, tying Demarcus Lawrence for the most in the league since 2017.
- His 43.5 career sacks are the most among all No. 1 overall picks in their first 52 games.

RB Kareem Hunt

- RB Kareem Hunt finished the day with six carries (700th career) for 33 yards and a touchdown. He also added three catches for 28 receiving yards.
- Hunt's teams are 22-6 when he scores a touchdown since joining the league in 2017.

- Hunt is only one of three players (RBs Christian McCaffrey and Alvin Kamara) since 2017 with 20 or more rushing touchdowns (24) and at least 15 receiving touchdowns (16).

WR Jarvis Landry

- WR Jarvis Landry has now recorded at least two receptions in 111 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the NFL and the fourth longest streak in NFL history.
- Landry caught five passes for 71 receiving yards and a five-yard rushing touchdown.
- Landry scored his fourth career-rushing touchdown on a five-yard attempt.
 - His four rushing TDs are tied for sixth most by a WR from 2014-present.
- Landry has recorded 75 games with five-plus receptions, trailing Larry Fitzgerald (76) for eighth most by a player in their first eight seasons.

Other Notes

- TE David Njoku snagged three catches for a team-leading 76 receiving yards. Most yards by him since his four reception, 74-yard game on Dec. 3, 2017 against the Los Angeles Chargers.
- WR Anthony Schwartz caught his first career reception on his first-ever target. He ended the day with three catches for 69 yards. His two grabs for 60 receiving yards in the first quarter are the most by a Browns rookie in the first quarter of a game and fourth all-time in NFL history.
- DE Joe Jackson notched his first career NFL sack.
- DE Malik McDowell made his NFL debut and first NFL start. He also collected his first career tackle that resulted in a tackle for loss on the team's first defensive play of the game.
- DE Jadeveon Clowney made his 75th career start.
- CB Greg Newsome II and LB Jeremiah Owusu-Koramoah made their first NFL start today.

Injury Report

- LT Jedrick Wills Jr. (ankle) left the game in the second quarter and did not return.
