## CAREER TRANSACTIONS

Selected by the Houston Texans in the first round (1st overall) of the 2014 NFL Draft... Traded to the Seattle Seahawks on Sept. 1, 2019...Signed by the Tennessee Titans on Sept. 8, 2020...Signed to the Cleveland Browns on April 14, 2021.

- Played three seasons (2011-13) at South Carolina, starting 23 of 36 games, recording 130 total tackles that included 24.0 sacks. Also recovered one fumble, forced nine others, and deflected seven passes.
- Holds the school record with nine forced fumbles.

- Earned second-team All-Pro in 2016.
- 2016 PFWA All-NFL and All-AFC.
- 2012 SEC Defensive Player of the Year.

## PERSONAL

- First name is pronounced Juh-deh-vee-uhn.
- Native of Rock Hill, S.C. and attended South Pointe High School where he was named South Carolina's Mr. Football. Also lettered in basketball and participated in track and field, competing as a sprinter, shot putter and discus thrower.
- Named the consensus best player in the nation and USA Today's National Defensive Player of the year in 2010.
- Majored in African American Studies at South Carolina.
- Cousin of former Canadian Football League player, David Clowney.

## KEY NOTES

- Over a four-season window from 2016 through 2019, was one of only three NFL players with at least 60 tackles for loss, eight forced fumbles and 150 quarterback pressures.
- Has scored four total touchdowns in his NFL career—three on fumble recoveries and one interception return.
- Appeared in 83 games (74 starts) and tallied 255 tackles, 32 sacks, 75 tackles for loss, 18 passes defended, 10 forced fumbles and seven fumble recoveries since entering the league in 2014.
- Posted single-season career high numbers in all major defensive categories in 2017: games played/games started (16), total tackles (59), sacks (9.5), tackles for loss (21), QB hits (21), forced fumbles (two) and fumble recoveries (two).
- One of two players in 2016 (Cameron Jordan) with at least 50 total tackles, six sacks, 16 tackles for loss and two pass breakups.

## BEYOND FOOTBALL

- Participated in My Cause, My Cleats supporting the Boys & Girls Club of Houston in 2016-17, working with the community to inspire and enable youth to reach their full potential.
- Hosts an annual free, three-day football camp for youth in his hometown of Rock Hill, S.C. through his H.I.T. Foundation.
