

POSTGAME NOTES

Cleveland Browns vs. Los Angeles Chargers

FirstEnergy Stadium | Oct. 9, 2022

TEAM

- The Browns rushed for 213 yards today, the 21st game since 2020 they've rushed for over 150 yards (leads NFL).
- The Browns rushing attack has posted five consecutive games of 150 rushing yards to start a season for the third time in team history, joining the 1947 and 2021 teams to accomplish the feat.
- Over the first five games, the team's 962 rushing yards are the third most by a Browns team through the first five weeks in history and the most by the club since rushing for 1,042 in 1963.
 - The group leads the league in rushing yards and second with 10 rushing touchdowns.
 - The Browns have now rushed for at least 100 yards in six straight games, the second-longest active streak in the NFL, behind the Buffalo Bills (10 games).

RB NICK CHUBB

- RB Nick Chubb rushed for 134 yards on 17 carries and two rushing scores.
 - This was Chubb's fourth consecutive game recording a rushing touchdown.
- Chubb has at least 100 rushing yards in four of the past five games and the lone player in league with 100-plus scrimmage yards in each of first five weeks.
- Chubb is the fourth active player since 2015 with four 100-yard rushing performances in the first five games of a season.
- He also logged his 26th game with 100-or-more rushing yards, the second most by an active player behind Ezekiel Elliott (26) in their first 63 games.
- Chubb has rushed for 100 yards in three consecutive contests, tied for the longest streak of his career (Weeks 10-12 in 2020).
- His 26 career games with 100-or-more rushing yards places him one back of Leroy Kelly for the second most in franchise history:

- Chubb's 26 100-yard games are the most in the league since 2018. They are also the most by a player in their first five seasons in that span.
- Chubb's 593 rushing yards this season are the third most by a Brown after the first five weeks of a season and the most since Jim Brown recorded 787 in 1963.
- Today marked Chubb's 53rd game tallying 50-or-more scrimmage yards, the most by a Brown in their first 63 career games.
- Chubb's 43 career touchdowns are ranked sixth in franchise history, trailing Otto Graham by one:

- Chubb has reached 50 rushing yards in 51 games since he was drafted in 2018, four games from passing Jim Brown for most by a Brown in their first five years. The 51 games are also the most amongst all Browns in their first 63 games.
- Chubb's seven rushing touchdowns tie for third most by a Browns player through the first five games of a season:

- The 51 games Chubb has rushed for more than 50 yards are the second most by an active player in their first five seasons behind Ezekiel Elliott (59).
- Chubb (5,375) is now 122 yards behind Greg Pruitt for the fourth-most rushing yards in Browns' history:

- His 10 games with multiple rushing touchdowns are two away from tying Mike Pruitt for the third most in Browns' history.

WR AMARI COOPER

- WR Amari Cooper tallied seven receptions for 76 yards and a touchdown. He leads the team in catches (27), receiving yards (306) and touchdowns (three).
- Cooper's 27 receptions are the fourth-most by a Browns WR in the first five weeks of a season and the most since Jarvis Landry recorded 29 in 2018.
- Cooper's 49 receiving touchdowns broke a tie with Keyshawn Johnson and took sole possession of sixth most by a top-five pick in their first eight years. Cooper is now only one back of matching for fourth with Wes Chandler and Andre Johnson's 50.

- He currently sits 71 yards back from passing Wes Chandler for the sixth-most receiving yards by a top-five pick in their first eight seasons.
- Cooper (48) is tied for the 12th most games registering five catches for 50-or-more receiving yards from 2015-22.

TE DAVID NJOKU

- TE David Njoku entered the 2,000-yard receiving club after catching the ball six times for 88 yards.
- Njoku notched his third game in row with at least five catches and 70 receiving yards.
- Njoku is just 417 yards behind Kellen Winslow for the third-most receiving yards by a tight end in club history.
 - He is one-of-four tight ends in Browns' history to hit 2,000 receiving yards.

CB DENZEL WARD

- CB Denzel Ward tallied a career high 10 tackles (nine solo).
- He is second all-time in Browns' history with 56 pass deflections:

- Since 2018, Ward's 56 pass deflections are tied for third in the NFL with Xavien Howard.
- He sits at fifth for the most by a top-five pick in their first five years, trailing Patrick Peterson by one (57).

OTHER NOTES

- DE Jadeveon Clowney appeared in his 100th regular season game and reached 300 (302) total tackles for his career.
- RB Kareem Hunt scored his 30th career rushing touchdown on a two-yard run in the third quarter.
 - He finished the game with 11 carries for 47 yards and one rushing score. In addition, he caught three passes for 10 yards.
- WR Donovan Peoples-Jones recorded four receptions for 50 yards on the day.

- LB Jacob Phillips tied a career-high 10 tackles and added one sack.

- CB Denzel Ward suffered a concussion during today's game.
