DE Myles Garrett

- DE Myles Garrett recorded four tackles, three tackles for loss, one sack and one pass defensed. He extended his Browns single-season sack record to 20. Garrett has recorded at least one sack in each of the past seven games, the longest streak of his career. His 20 sacks are tied for the 12-most by an NFL player in a season.

- With 122.5 career sacks, Garrett increased his lead over Pro Football Hall of Famer Reggie White (108) for the most sacks by a player under the age of 30. Garrett turns 30 years old on Dec. 29, 2025.

QB Shedeur Sanders

- Rookie QB Shedeur Sanders completed 23 of 42 passes for 364 yards with three touchdowns and one rushing score. Sanders became the first Browns player to throw for at least 300 yards and have at least three touchdown passes and one rushing touchdown in a game. His 364 passing yards tied for the third-most by a Browns rookie in a game and his three touchdown passes tied for the second most. He has completed at least one pass for 50-plus yards in each of his first three NFL starts. Sanders joined Tim Couch (three) and Baker Mayfield (17) as the only QBs in Browns history to throw a touchdown pass in each of their first three starts to begin their career.

TE Harold Fannin Jr.

- Rookie TE Harold Fannin Jr. recorded eight receptions for 114 yards and one touchdown. He joined Ozzie Newsome (124 on Nov. 5, 1978) as the only rookie tight ends in Browns history to record 100-yards receiving in a game. Fannin became the first Browns rookie to reach 100 receiving yards in a game since Corey Coleman in 2016. Fannin is leading the team with 59 receptions this season, tied for the fourth-most by a Browns rookie. He is tied for the team lead with four receiving touchdowns this season.

LB Carson Schwegsinger

- Rookie LB Carson Schwegsinger led the team with 12 tackles, his fifth game with double-digit tackles this season and fourth consecutive. He is leading the team with 111 tackles, the most by a Browns rookie since 1999.

- The Browns have gone 41 straight games without allowing a 300-yard passer, the longest active streak in the NFL and the longest streak by any NFL team since the Colts went 52 games from 2005-08.

- WR Jerry Jeudy recorded three receptions for 76 yards and one touchdown. He scored on a 60-yard pass, his longest reception of the season. He has two touchdowns on the season.

- TE David Njoku recorded a 1-yard touchdown catch. He has four receiving touchdowns this season and 34 in his career, the most by any Brown since 1999.

- Rookie RB Quinshon Judkins rushed for 26 yards and added a career-long 58 yard reception. He has 784 rushing yards on the season, the fifth-most by a Browns rookie.

LB Devin Bush

- LB Devin Bush recorded nine tackles, two passes defensed and an interception. He tied his career high with two interceptions this season.
