

- Last week the Browns dropped their season opener 17-16 to the Bengals. The Browns defense limited the Bengals to 141 net yards and 95 net passing yards. DE Myles Garrett recorded two sacks, while DE Isaiah McGuire added one. WR Cedric Tillman recorded a touchdown catch, while rookie RB Raheim Sanders added a rushing score.
- Four rookies started for the Browns last week, and each made their mark in their NFL debut. Rookie RB Dylan Sampson led all NFL rookies with eight receptions. Rookie TE Harold Fannin Jr. set an NFL record for receptions by a rookie TE in Week 1 with seven, tied for the second-most among all NFL TEs this season. Rookie LB Carson Schwesinger led the team with eight tackles. Rookie DT Mason Graham recorded three tackles and helped limit the Bengals to just 46 net rushing yards.
- The Browns voted five season-long captains for the 2025 season. G Joel Bitonio and QB Joe Flacco were selected from the offense, DE Myles Garrett and CB Denzel Ward from the defense and P Corey Bojorquez from special teams. Three of the five captains served in the role during the 2024 season, with Bojorquez and Flacco stepping into the new role for the 2025 season.
- This offseason, the Browns signed QB Joe Flacco, who spent a portion of the 2023 season with the club. That season, Flacco went 4-1 as a starter, while becoming the first player in Browns history to throw for 300 yards in four consecutive games en route to being named the NFL Comeback Player of the Year. In six career starts as a Brown, Flacco is averaging 317.6 passing yards per game, while totaling 14 touchdown passes. He owns a 105-87 (.547) career record as a starter.
- In the season opener, DE Myles Garrett recorded five tackles, four tackles-for-a-loss and two sacks. He currently leads the NFL in tackles-for-a-loss and is tied for second in sacks. Last season, Garrett led the NFL with 22 tackles-for-a-loss and finished second in the league with 14 sacks. Garrett also became the first player in NFL history to record at least 14 sacks in four consecutive seasons (2021-24). He joined Hall of Famer Lawrence Taylor as the only NFL players to record at least 12 sacks in five consecutive seasons (2020-24). Garrett is the only NFL player to record at least 10 sacks in each of the past seven seasons (2018-24).
- WR Jerry Jeudy led the team last week with 66 receiving yards. Last season Jeudy led the Browns with career highs in receptions (90) and receiving yards (1,229), while adding four touchdowns. Jeudy's 90 receptions set a single-season franchise record and his 1,229 receiving yards were the fifthmost. Jeudy joined Amari Cooper (1,160 yards in 2022) and Odell Beckham Jr. (1,035 yards in 2019) as the only players in Browns history to record 1,000 receiving yards in their first season with the team.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR THIS WEEK

TEAM

- The team has gone 29 straight games without allowing a 300-yard passer, the longest streak in the NFL.
- The team looks to have back-to-back games allowing less than 150 total net yards for the first time in team history.

DE MYLES GARRETT

- Three and a half sacks pass Derrick Thomas (107.5) for fifth most sacks by a player in their first nine seasons.
- Needs four sacks to surpass Reggie White (108) for the most sacks by a player under the age of 30.
- Can become the first Browns player to record at least two sacks in consecutive games since Jadeveon Clowney did Week 17-18 of the 2022 season.
- Three sacks tie himself for the most sacks (5) by a Brown through the first two games of a season. Two ties Keith McKenzie and Michael Dean Perry with four.

OB JOE FLACCO

• 13 yards from 46,000 in his career...Can be the 18th QB in NFL history to do so.

CB DENZEL WARD

- Four pass deflections from 100 career.
- One game away with multiple pass deflections from passing Joe Haden (28) for most all-time by a Brown.

RB DYLAN SAMPSON

- Needs five receptions to join Eric Metcalf and Odell Beckham Jr. (13) to tie for the fourth most receptions by a Brown in their first two games of season. Greg Pruitt (16), Jordan Cameron and Andrew Hawkins (14) round up the top three
- Two receptions tie Bijan Robinson and Chuck Foreman (10) for seventh most receptions by a rookie in their first two games. Four ties John Riggins (12), six ties Jahvid Best (14).

TE HAROLD FANNIN JR.

• Needs six receptions to tie Beckham Jr. and Metcalf. Greg Pruitt (16), Jordan Cameron and Andrew Hawkins (14) round up the top three.

BROWNS GIVE BACK

The Browns have a unified and focused philanthropic mission with "Browns Give Back" that extends throughout Northeast Ohio. Led by Dee and Jimmy Haslam,
Whitney and JW Johnson, David Jenkins, Andrew Berry and Kevin Stefanski, the entire Browns organization - coaches, players and
front office members - are dedicated to creating meaningful impact in the communities in which we live and work by investing their
time and resources under the Browns Give Back platform.

The target of these endeavors devotes to three focus areas: EDUCATION, YOUTH FOOTBALL and EQUITABLE OPPORTUNITIES across Northeast Ohio and beyond.

UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS AT ARBOR ELEMENTARY

The Cleveland Browns and UH created a Wellness Room in Arbor Elementary to help students decompress when they were stressed, tired or angry. As part of the initiative, two nurses from UH visited the school to train faculty and staff on how to utilize the space effectively. During the training, they walked teachers through the escalation cycle, de-escalation strategies, stress responses in kids and common behaviors to observe. The goal was to equip teachers with tools to meet students where they are and help keep them in school.





SITG! Incentive Kit Pickup

The Browns hosted district partners at the CrossCountry Mortgage Campus for the annual SITG! Incentive Kit Pickup. Each district received a kit, filled with Browns-themed attendance incentives such as fidget toys, notebooks, Rubik's cubes, stress balls, and stickers to support attendance-related efforts. In addition to the incentive kits, partners were offered shoes for students and faculty, water bottles, bulletin board-making kits, and a sweet treat from the Cleveland Cookie Dough Co. food truck.



Launched in 2019 by the Cleveland Browns Foundation, Ohio Department of Education and Workforce and Harvard's Proving Ground, the Stay in the Game! Attendance Network, now managed by Battelle, works together to reduce chronic absenteeism by bringing together experts, partners, and communities. When students miss school, they lose valuable learning opportunities that can be difficult, or even impossible, to recover. Stay in the Game! partners with 200+ districts across Ohio positively impacting more than 550,000 students by equipping districts with resources and strategies to better engage learners and keep them in the classroom.

BACK TO SCHOOL!

On Tuesday, September 2nd, Browns G Joel Bitonio kicked off Attendance Awareness Month with his annual back-to-school event at Constellation Schools: Stockyard. The event brought together K-8 students for an afternoon featuring youth football activations and minute-to-win-it style games. Each student received a Nike backpack filled with school supplies courtesy of Bitonio, and he shared a brief message to encourage students as they began the new school year.



THE HEAD COACHES

BROWNS HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI



Head Coach Kevin Stefanski became the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history on January 13, 2020. In Stefanski's six years, the Browns are 40-45 (.471). The two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year led the Browns to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons becoming the second coach in club history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins

(Paul Brown, 1951 and 1953). In his first season, he led the club to their first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years, earning him his first AP Coach of the Year. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski spent 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings in various roles. Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach, assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanski played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania, where he recorded 49 tackles, a forced fumble and one fumble. recovery in 10 games played.

RAVENS HEAD COACH JOHN HARBAUGH



John Harbaugh is in his 18th season as head coach of the Baltimore Ravens, the second-longest tenured head coach across the NFL. The 2019 Coach of the Year has led the Ravens to the playoffs in 12 of his 17 seasons (2008-12, 2018-20 & 2022-24) while winning Baltimore their second Super Bowl in team history in 2012. Over his 17 seasons, Harbaugh has captured 185 total victories, tying Mike McCarthy for 12th-

most by a head coach in NFL history. Additionally, his 13 playoff victories tied Mike Holmgren for seventh-most all time, while eight of those 13 wins have been on the road, an NFL-best. During Harbaugh's career, he boasts the second-highest home winning percentage (.717) over that time period (2008-24), going 99-39 at M&T Bank Stadium. The Toledo native became the first head coach in NFL history to win a playoff game each of his first five seasons.



- Ravens Quarterbacks Coach Tee Martin (2019-20) also coached Browns WR Cedric Tillman (2019-20) during his time at Tennessee.

HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Stefanski has led the team to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons. He joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.
- Stefanski became the 16th coach to win the Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award multiple times since its inception in 1957. Stefanski won the honors in 2020 and 2023 and joined Forrest Gregg (1976) as the only Browns coaches to win the award.
- During the Browns 78-year history, the team has surpassed 6,000 scrimmage yards in a single season just seven times, but have reached the mark in four seasons under Stefanski. Since 2020, the Browns are fifth in the NFL with an average of 130.5 rushing yards per game.
- Stefanski has recorded a 26-17 (.604) record at Huntington Bank Field, while not recording a losing record at home in any season. The Browns finished 8-1 at home in 2023, a team record for wins at home.
- In his first season with the Browns, Stefanski led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years. He notched the most wins (11) by a first-year Browns head coach since Paul Brown had 12 in the team's inaugural season in 1946. Stefanski's 11 regular season wins were the most by a first-year head coach in 2020 and marked just the 11th time since 1970 a first-year coach has won 11 or more games. Stefanski was named the NFL Coach of the Year.

BUBBA VENTRONE | ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR

Ventrone brings 20 years of coaching and playing experience in the NFL with experience in two Super Bowls. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native joined the Browns ahead of the 2023 season and aided a special teams unit that set several franchise records including 33 made field goals and a 49.4-yard punt average and three blocked field goals. Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Ventrone spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts guiding the unit to a top-10 finish in his last three seasons. As an assistant special teams coach with the New England Patriots from 2015-17, he was a member of the Super Bowl LI winning team.



JIM SCHWARTZ | DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Schwartz is in his 17th season as an NFL defensive coordinator and his second with the Cleveland Browns. In his first season with the Browns, Schwartz won NFL Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the defense to several NFL-leading categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Schwartz was a defensive coordinator with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-20), winning Super Bowl LII, Buffalo Bills (2014) and Tennessee Titans (2001-08). The Baltimore, Md. native served as the head coach of the Detroit Lions from 2009-13, coaching the team to a 10-6 season in 2011 and a playoff berth for the first time since 1999.



TOMMY REES | OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Rees joined the Browns staff as tight ends/pass game specialist in 2024 and was hired as offensive coordinator in 2025. Rees spent the 2023 season as Alabama's offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach, helping the Crimson Tide win the SEC Championship Game and advance to the College Football Playoffs. Prior to Alabama, Rees spent six seasons as a coach at Notre Dame (2017-22), first coaching the quarterbacks and adding the role as offensive coordinator in 2020. In three years as Notre Dame's offensive coordinator, the team averaged more than 30 points per game each year and advanced to the College Football Playoffs in 2020 after posting an undefeated regular season.



CHAD O'SHEA | PASS GAME COORDINATOR/WIDE RECEIVERS

O'Shea joined the Browns in 2020 and is in his 22nd NFL season, winning 12 division titles, five conference championships and three Super Bowls (XLIX, LI and LIII). The Browns' offense saw Amari Cooper post back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in 2022, the first Brown to do so. In his first season, O'Shea aided the offense to 408 points, the second most in franchise history. Previously, the Houston, Texas native spent the 2019 season as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins and 2018-19 as the New England Patriots wide receivers coach.


