

NOTABLE STORYLINES

- The Browns host the Baltimore Ravens at 4:25 p.m. on Sunday, Nov. 16. The Ravens topped the Browns, 41-17, in Baltimore in Week 2 this season, but the teams have split the season series each of the past four seasons. The Browns have won three of their past four meetings with the Ravens in Cleveland, including a 29-24 victory in 2024.
- Last week, DE Myles Garrett recorded two tackles for loss and one sack. He is leading the NFL with 17 tackles for loss and is tied for first with 11 sacks. Earlier this year, Garrett joined Pro Football Hall of Famers Reggie White (1995-85) and John Randle (1992-99) as the only players in NFL history to record at least 10 sacks in eight consecutive seasons. With 113.5 career sacks, Garrett passed White (108) for the most sacks by a player under the age of 30. Garrett turns 30 years old on Dec. 29, 2025.
- The Browns are second the NFL in total defense, allowing just 264.9 yards per game. The team is also second in pass defense (167.0 yards per game) and eighth in run defense (97.9 yards per game). The Browns haven't allowed a 300-yard passer in 37 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the NFL.
- The Browns 2025 draft class is making a significant impact:
 - First round pick DT Mason Graham has recorded 20 tackles, half of a sack and helped anchor a defense that is second in the NFL in total defense.
 - Second round pick LB Carson Schwesinger is leading the team with 69 tackles, while adding 1.5 sacks and one interception. He is leading all NFL rookies in tackles. Schwesinger is also the only NFL rookie to record at least 15 tackles, one interception and one sack this season.
 - Second round pick RB Quinshon Judkins is leading the team with 561 rushing yards and five rushing scores. Earlier this year, he became the first Browns player ever to record at least 70 scrimmage yards in each of their first four career games. He is leading all NFL rookies in rushing yards and is tied for second in rushing touchdowns. Judkins' four runs of 30-plus yards are tied second among all NFL players this season.
 - Third round pick TE Harold Fannin Jr. is leading the Browns with 42 receptions, the most by any Browns rookie in the first 10 weeks. He is third among all NFL rookies in receptions and fifth in receiving yards (396).
 - In five career starts, third round pick QB Dillon Gabriel has seven touchdown passes and two interceptions. He began his career with 121 passing attempts without throwing an interception until throwing his first in the third quarter at New England (10/26).

- CB Denzel Ward has recorded 26 tackles, one interception and five passes defended this season. He has 18 interceptions in his career and with one more he will extend his streak of recording at least two interceptions every season since being drafted in the first round by the Browns in 2018. The four-time Pro Bowler has 100 career passes defended, the most by any player in the NFL since 2018. He is one of just three active players with 100 career passes defended.
- CB Tyson Campbell joined the Browns via trade prior to Week 6. In four games with the Browns, he has recorded 17 tackles, one interception (returned for a touchdown), five passes defended and one forced fumble. He is third in the NFL this season with 11 passes defended.
- Last week, G Joel Bitonio appeared in and started his 170th career game, the 11th most on the Browns career games played list. His 170 career starts are the most by a Brown since the team returned in 1999. Bitonio has been selected to seven career Pro Bowls.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR THIS WEEK

TEAM

- The team has gone 37 straight games without allowing a 300-yard passer, the longest active streak in the NFL.

LB DEVIN BUSH

- Aims for at least five tackles in every game this season.

DE MYLES GARRETT

- Two sacks away (13) from the most by a Brown through the first 10 games of a season, matching the 13 he had through that same span in 2023.
- Needs one sack to become the first player since 1982 to reach 12 in six straight seasons, surpassing Lawrence Taylor (five from 1985-89).
- Two sacks away from breaking a tie with T.J. Watt (four) and Reggie White (four) as only player in league history with five straight seasons tallying minimum 13 sacks.

TE DAVID NJOKU

- 99 receiving yards away from the ninth most career receiving yards by a Brown. Would pass Brian Brennan (4,148).
- One touchdown breaks tie with Dante Lavelli (33) for the fifth most career receiving touchdowns by a Brown.

LB CARSON SCHWESINGER

- Aims for eighth game in a row with seven-or-more tackles.
- Four tackles pass TJ Ward (72 in 2010) for the most tackles by a Browns rookie through the first 10 games of a season.

CB DENZEL WARD

- One game away with multiple pass deflections to pass Joe Haden (28) for most all-time by a Brown.
- Two interceptions from 20 career.

As part of the NFL's Salute to Service initiative, the Cleveland Browns will show their year-round commitment to honoring active-duty service members, veterans, and their families during Sunday's game against the Baltimore Ravens. This year's game is presented by CrossCountry Mortgage (CCM), the official mortgage partner of the Browns, which actively supports the team's military appreciation efforts through Salute to Service and other initiatives throughout the year. From celebrating first responders and surprising veterans with game-day experiences to assembling care packages for the USO, the Browns are dedicating the month of November to recognizing and thanking those who have served and continue to serve for their endless commitment.

WYATT TELLER SALUTE TO SERVICE NOMINEE

The NFL and USAA, an official Salute to Service partner, announced this year's nominees for the Salute to Service Award. Each season, the award recognizes players, coaches, staff and alumni who go above and beyond in honoring and supporting the military and veteran communities. On Friday, Nov. 8, the Browns nominated guard Wyatt Teller as their 2025 nominee. Teller remains deeply committed to his community, particularly the Northern Ohio military-and-veteran network, and supports causes like the Green Beret Foundation, which provides vital assistance to U.S. Army Special Forces soldiers and their families.



VETERANS SUPERBOWL SURPRISE



On November 10, CrossCountry Mortgage surprised a Lincoln-West School of Science and Health educator who is a military veteran with a round-trip travel experience for the 2026 Super Bowl. A longtime partner of the Browns' SITG! was chosen for its strong attendance and military community support. During the event, more than 60 Junior ROTC students, G Wyatt Teller and former CB Hanford Dixon assembled care kits for deployed service members.




VETERANS AWAY GAME SURPRISE



In collaboration with United Airlines, the Browns were honored to host four veterans from the US Armed Forces and their guests for a guided tour of CrossCountry Mortgage Campus. The group saw the key areas of the facility including the locker room, practice fields, and team meeting rooms to give them an overview of the operations behind the Browns. The tour ended with RB Quinshon Judkins and DE Cameron Thomas surprising them with a surprise trip to Chicago to attend the Browns game against the Chicago Bears.

THE HEAD COACHES

BROWNS HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI



Head Coach Kevin Stefanski became the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history on January 13, 2020. In Stefanski's six years, the Browns are 42-51 (.452). The two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year led the Browns to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons, becoming the second coach in club history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins (Paul

Brown, 1951 and 1953). In his first season, he led the club to their first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years, earning him his first AP Coach of the Year award. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski spent 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings in various roles. Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach, assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanski played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania, where he recorded 49 tackles, a forced fumble and one fumble recovery in 10 games played.

RAVENS HEAD COACH JOHN HARBAUGH



John Harbaugh is in his 18th season as head coach of the Baltimore Ravens, the second-longest tenured head coach across the NFL. The 2019 Coach of the Year has led the Ravens to the playoffs in 12 of his 17 seasons (2008-12, 2018-20 & 2022-24) while winning Baltimore their second Super Bowl in team history in 2012. Over his 17 seasons, Harbaugh has captured 185 total victories, tying Mike McCarthy for 12th-most by a head coach in NFL history.

Additionally, his 13 playoff victories tied Mike Holmgren for seventh-most all time, while eight of those 13 wins have been on the road, an NFL-best. During Harbaugh's career, he boasts the second-highest home winning percentage (.717) over that time period (2008-24), going 99-39 at M&T Bank Stadium. The Toledo native became the first head coach in NFL history to win a playoff game each of his first five seasons.







HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Stefanski has led the team to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons. He joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.
- Stefanski became the 16th coach to win the Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award multiple times since its inception in 1957. Stefanski won the honors in 2020 and 2023 and joined Forrest Gregg (1976) as the only Browns coaches to win the award.
- During the Browns 78-year history, the team has surpassed 6,000 scrimmage yards in a single season just seven times, but have reached the mark in four seasons under Stefanski. Since 2020, the Browns are fifth in the NFL with an average of 130.5 rushing yards per game.
- Stefanski has recorded a 28-17 (.622) record at Huntington Bank Field, while not recording a losing record at home in any season. The Browns finished 8-1 at home in 2023, a team record for wins at home.
- In his first season with the Browns, Stefanski led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years. He notched the most wins (11) by a first-year Browns head coach since Paul Brown had 12 in the team's inaugural season in 1946. Stefanski's 11 regular season wins were the most by a first-year head coach in 2020 and marked just the 11th time since 1970 a first-year coach has won 11 or more games. Stefanski was named the NFL Coach of the Year.

BUBBA VENTRONE | ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR

Ventrone brings 20 years of coaching and playing experience in the NFL with experience in two Super Bowls. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native joined the Browns ahead of the 2023 season and aided a special teams unit that set several franchise records including 33 made field goals and a 49.4-yard punt average and three blocked field goals. Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Ventrone spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts guiding the unit to a top-10 finish in his last three seasons. As an assistant special teams coach with the New England Patriots from 2015-17, he was a member of the Super Bowl LI winning team.



JIM SCHWARTZ | DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Schwartz is in his 17th season as an NFL defensive coordinator and his second with the Cleveland Browns. In his first season with the Browns, Schwartz won NFL Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the defense to several NFL-leading categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Schwartz was a defensive coordinator with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-20), winning Super Bowl LII, Buffalo Bills (2014) and Tennessee Titans (2001-08). The Baltimore, Md. native served as the head coach of the Detroit Lions from 2009-13, coaching the team to a 10-6 season in 2011 and a playoff berth for the first time since 1999.



TOMMY REES | OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Rees joined the Browns staff as tight ends/pass game specialist in 2024 and was hired as offensive coordinator in 2025. Rees spent the 2023 season as Alabama's offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach, helping the Crimson Tide win the SEC Championship Game and advance to the College Football Playoffs. Prior to Alabama, Rees spent six seasons as a coach at Notre Dame (2017-22), first coaching the quarterbacks and adding the role as offensive coordinator in 2020. In three years as Notre Dame's offensive coordinator, the team averaged more than 30 points per game each year and advanced to the College Football Playoffs in 2020 after posting an undefeated regular season.



CHAD O'SHEA | PASS GAME COORDINATOR/WIDE RECEIVERS

O'Shea joined the Browns in 2020 and is in his 22nd NFL season, winning 12 division titles, five conference championships and three Super Bowls (XLIX, LI and LIII). The Browns' offense saw Amari Cooper post back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in 2022, the first Brown to do so. In his first season, O'Shea aided the offense to 408 points, the second most in franchise history. Previously, the Houston, Texas native spent the 2019 season as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins and 2018-19 as the New England Patriots wide receivers coach.
