

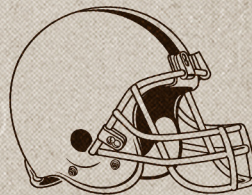

The Browns return home to host the Green Bay Packers at Huntington Bank Field at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, Sept. 21. The Packers lead the all-time regular season series 13-7, including a win when the teams last met in 2021. Since Kevin Stefanski was hired as head coach in 2020, the Browns are 26-17 (.605) at Huntington Bank Field.

NOTABLE STORYLINES

- The Browns defense leads the NFL this season in total defense and run defense, while ranking third in pass defense. The Browns haven't allowed a 300-yard passer in 30 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the NFL.
- DE Myles Garrett is leading the NFL this season with six tackles for loss and is tied for first with 3.5 sacks. Last season, Garrett led the NFL with 22 tackles for loss and finished second in the league with 14 sacks. Garrett also became the first player in NFL history to record at least 14 sacks in four consecutive seasons (2021-24). He joined Hall of Famer Lawrence Taylor as the only NFL players to record at least 12 sacks in five consecutive seasons (2020-24). Garrett is the only NFL player to record at least 10 sacks in each of the past seven seasons (2018-24).
- Rookie TE Harold Fannin Jr. is leading the Browns and all NFL rookies with 12 receptions this season. His 12 receptions are tied for the second-most by an NFL rookie TE in the first two weeks of a season. They are also the most by any Browns rookie in the first two weeks.
- Rookie RB Dylan Sampson is tied for second among all NFL rookies with 11 receptions. He registered his first career touchdown on an 8-yard pass last week at Baltimore.
- Rookie RB Quinshon Judkins made his NFL debut last week and led the team with 61 rushing yards, while adding three receptions for 10 yards. Judkins recorded a 31-yard rush, the Browns longest play of the season.
- This offseason, the Browns signed QB Joe Flacco, who spent a portion of the 2023 season with the club. That season, Flacco went 4-1 as a starter, while becoming the first player in Browns history to throw for 300 yards in four consecutive games en route to being named the NFL Comeback Player of the Year. In seven career starts as a Brown, Flacco is averaging 300.7 passing yards per game, while totaling 15 touchdown passes. He owns a 105-88 (.544) career record as a starter.
- WR Jerry Jeudy is leading the team with 117 receiving yards. Since joining the Browns in 2024, Jeudy's 1,346 receiving yards and 99 receptions are each the most by any Browns player in their first 19 games with the team. Last season, Jeudy led the Browns with career highs in receptions (90) and receiving yards (1,229), while adding four touchdowns. Jeudy's 90 receptions set a single-season franchise record and his 1,229 receiving yards were the fifth-most.
- WR Cedric Tillman has recorded seven receptions for 74 yards and two touchdowns. Tillman is one of six WRs this season to record a touchdown catch in each of his team's first two games.
- The Browns voted five season-long captains for the 2025 season. G Joel Bitonio and QB Joe Flacco were selected from the offense, DE Myles Garrett and CB Denzel Ward from the defense and P Corey Bojorquez from special teams. Three of the five captains served in the role during the 2024 season, with Bojorquez and Flacco stepping into the new role for the 2025 season.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR THIS WEEK

TEAM

- The team has gone 30 straight games without allowing a 300-yard passer, the longest active streak in the NFL.

DE MYLES GARRETT

- Two sacks pass Derrick Thomas (107.5) for fifth most sacks by a player in their first nine seasons.
- Needs 2.5 sacks to surpass Reggie White (108) for the most sacks by a player under the age of 30.
- Can become the first Browns player to record at least 1.5 sacks in three consecutive games since Jadeveon Clowney in the 2021 season.
- 2.5 sacks tie himself for the most sacks (6) by a Brown through the first three games of a season. One ties himself for third most in 2023 and two ties him for second in 2021.

QB JOE FLACCO

- 37 passing yards passes Vinny Testaverde for 17th all-time in NFL passing yards and 62 passes Carson Palmer for 16th most.

CB DENZEL WARD

- Four pass deflections from 100 career.
- One game away with multiple pass deflections from passing Joe Haden (28) for most all-time by a Brown.

RB DYLAN SAMPSON

- Two receptions pass Brian Brennan (12) for the most receptions by a Browns rookie in their first three games of a season.

TE HAROLD FANNIN JR.

- One reception passes Brian Brennan (12) for the most receptions by a Browns rookie in their first three games of a season.
- Six receptions tie Brock Bowers and Sam LaPorta (18) for the most by an NFL rookie TE through the first three games of a season.

BROWNS GIVE BACK

The Browns have a unified and focused philanthropic mission with "Browns Give Back" that extends throughout Northeast Ohio. Led by Dee and Jimmy Haslam, Whitney and JW Johnson, David Jenkins, Andrew Berry and Kevin Stefanski, the entire Browns organization - coaches, players and front office members - are dedicated to creating meaningful impact in the communities in which we live and work by investing their time and resources under the Browns Give Back platform.

The target of these endeavors devotes to three focus areas: **EDUCATION**, **YOUTH FOOTBALL** and **EQUITABLE OPPORTUNITIES** across Northeast Ohio and beyond.

BROWNS ROOKIE TACKLE

On September 6th, the Cleveland Browns hosted a Play Football Takeover at the Dream Youth Football Conference. The takeover featured interactive activities, including the Browns tent and the "Deal or No Deal" QB toss, where kids competed for prizes. With the supportive atmosphere, this takeover created memorable experiences for players, families, and fans while showcasing the Browns' commitment to growing the game.



HIGH SCHOOL GAME OF THE WEEK

Southeast High School defeated Newton Falls High School 53-28 at Freedom Field on Sept. 12. Southeast head coach Pat Youel earned the Coach of the Week title, while Peyton Donovan was named the game's MVP. Youel, who serves as both Southeast's head football coach and athletic director, had begun coaching at the school in 2014. Newton Falls entered the matchup 0-3, while Southeast stood 1-2 through the first three weeks of the 2025 campaign. Both schools compete in the Mahoning Valley-Grey Conference.



STAY IN THE GAME!

KEEP LEARNING, EVERY DAY

Launched in 2019 by the Cleveland Browns Foundation, Ohio Department of Education and Workforce and Harvard's Proving Ground, the Stay in the Game! Attendance Network, now managed by Battelle, works together to reduce chronic absenteeism by bringing together experts, partners, and communities. When students miss school, they lose valuable learning opportunities that can be difficult, or even impossible, to recover. Stay in the Game! partners with **200+ districts** across Ohio positively impacting **more than 550,000 students** by equipping districts with resources and strategies to better engage learners and keep them in the classroom.

READING UNDER THE LIGHTS

On September 8, the Browns and Chomps, visited Norwalk City Schools to support the district's attendance initiatives and participate in the Reading Under the Lights event. Under the glow of the football field lights, families spread out picnic blankets and enjoyed reading their favorite books together. Chomps made his way through the event, greeting students and families, posing for photos, and energizing the crowd.



THE HEAD COACHES

BROWNS HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI



Head Coach Kevin Stefanski became the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history on January 13, 2020. In Stefanski's six years, the Browns are 40-46 (.465). The two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year led the Browns to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons, becoming the second coach in club history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins (Paul Brown, 1951 and 1953). In his first season, he led the club to their first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years, earning him his first AP Coach of the Year award. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski spent 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings in various roles. Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach, assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanski played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania, where he recorded 49 tackles, a forced fumble and one fumble recovery in 10 games played.

PACKERS HEAD COACH MATT LAFLEUR



Matt LaFleur was named the Green Bay Packers' 15th head coach in franchise history on Jan. 8th, 2019. Since his arrival, LaFleur has guided the team to a 69-33 record and has made the postseason in five of six seasons, tied for the third most appearances across the NFL over that span (2019-24). In his first six seasons, LaFleur has helped guide the Packers to top-10 rankings in total defense, scoring defense, offense, scoring offense, giveaways and takeaways: They are the only team to finish that high in all six categories. In 2020 and 2021, the Michigan native helped Aaron Rodgers secure back-to-back MVP awards, becoming one of five quarterbacks in NFL history to do so. Spent time with the Houston Texans (2008-09), Washington Redskins (2010-13), Atlanta Falcons (2015-16), Los Angeles Rams (2017) and Tennessee Titans (2018) before heading to Green Bay.

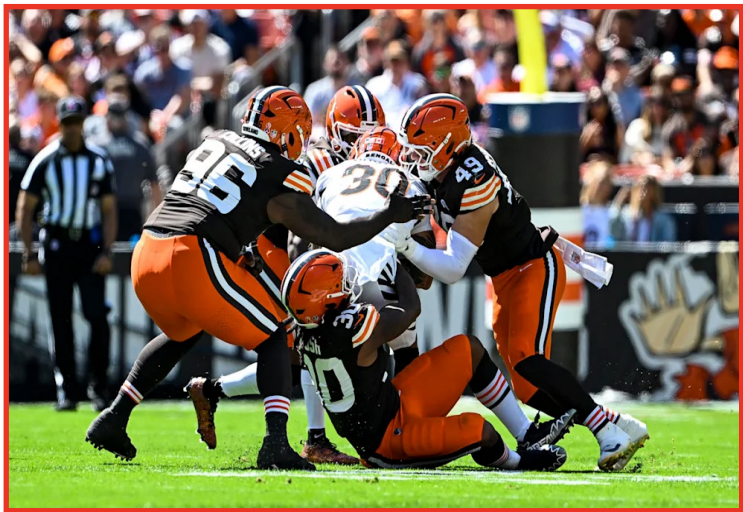

HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Stefanski has led the team to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons. He joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.
- Stefanski became the 16th coach to win the Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award multiple times since its inception in 1957. Stefanski won the honors in 2020 and 2023 and joined Forrest Gregg (1976) as the only Browns coaches to win the award.
- During the Browns 78-year history, the team has surpassed 6,000 scrimmage yards in a single season just seven times, but have reached the mark in four seasons under Stefanski. Since 2020, the Browns are fifth in the NFL with an average of 130.5 rushing yards per game.
- Stefanski has recorded a 26-17 (.604) record at Huntington Bank Field, while not recording a losing record at home in any season. The Browns finished 8-1 at home in 2023, a team record for wins at home.
- In his first season with the Browns, Stefanski led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years. He notched the most wins (11) by a first-year Browns head coach since Paul Brown had 12 in the team's inaugural season in 1946. Stefanski's 11 regular season wins were the most by a first-year head coach in 2020 and marked just the 11th time since 1970 a first-year coach has won 11 or more games. Stefanski was named the NFL Coach of the Year.

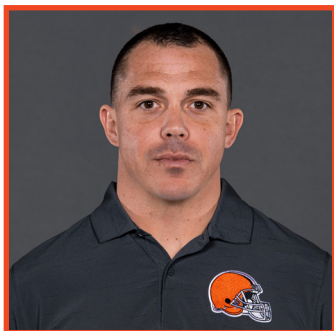

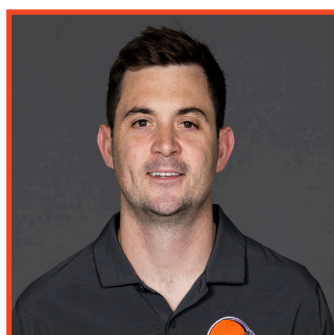
BUBBA VENTRONE | ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR

Ventrone brings 20 years of coaching and playing experience in the NFL with experience in two Super Bowls. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native joined the Browns ahead of the 2023 season and aided a special teams unit that set several franchise records including 33 made field goals and a 49.4-yard punt average and three blocked field goals. Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Ventrone spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts guiding the unit to a top-10 finish in his last three seasons. As an assistant special teams coach with the New England Patriots from 2015-17, he was a member of the Super Bowl LI winning team.



JIM SCHWARTZ | DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Schwartz is in his 17th season as an NFL defensive coordinator and his second with the Cleveland Browns. In his first season with the Browns, Schwartz won NFL Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the defense to several NFL-leading categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Schwartz was a defensive coordinator with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-20), winning Super Bowl LII, Buffalo Bills (2014) and Tennessee Titans (2001-08). The Baltimore, Md. native served as the head coach of the Detroit Lions from 2009-13, coaching the team to a 10-6 season in 2011 and a playoff berth for the first time since 1999.



TOMMY REES | OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

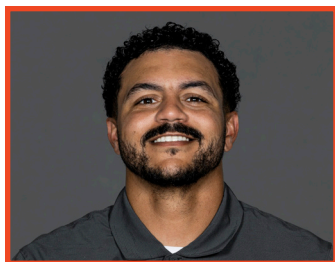
Rees joined the Browns staff as tight ends/pass game specialist in 2024 and was hired as offensive coordinator in 2025. Rees spent the 2023 season as Alabama's offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach, helping the Crimson Tide win the SEC Championship Game and advance to the College Football Playoffs. Prior to Alabama, Rees spent six seasons as a coach at Notre Dame (2017-22), first coaching the quarterbacks and adding the role as offensive coordinator in 2020. In three years as Notre Dame's offensive coordinator, the team averaged more than 30 points per game each year and advanced to the College Football Playoffs in 2020 after posting an undefeated regular season.



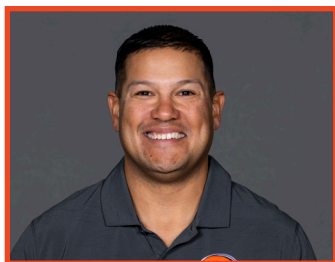
CHAD O'SHEA | PASS GAME COORDINATOR/WIDE RECEIVERS

O'Shea joined the Browns in 2020 and is in his 22nd NFL season, winning 12 division titles, five conference championships and three Super Bowls (XLIX, LI and LIII). The Browns' offense saw Amari Cooper post back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in 2022, the first Brown to do so. In his first season, O'Shea aided the offense to 408 points, the second most in franchise history. Previously, the Houston, Texas native spent the 2019 season as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins and 2018-19 as the New England Patriots wide receivers coach.
