

NOTABLE STORYLINES

- Last week, DE Myles Garrett recorded five tackles for a loss and four sacks. Coupled with a five-sack performance and a one sack game his previous two outings, Garrett tied an NFL record with 10 sacks over a three-game span. He also became just the fourth player in NFL history to record at least four sacks in multiple games during one season. Garrett is leading the NFL this season in sacks (15) and tackles for a loss (22). His 15 sacks are one away from tying the Browns franchise record for a season, which was set in 2021 and 2022. Garrett is the first player in NFL history to record at least 12 sacks in six consecutive seasons. With 117.5 career sacks, Garrett passed Reggie White (108) for the most sacks by a player under the age of 30. Garrett turns 30 years old on Dec. 29, 2025.
- The Browns are second in the NFL in total defense, allowing just 273.5 yards per game. The team is first in pass defense (167.0 yards per game) and 14th in run defense (106.5 yards per game). The Browns haven't allowed a 300-yard passer in 38 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the NFL.
- The Browns 2025 draft class is making a significant impact:
 - First round pick DT Mason Graham has recorded 22 tackles, half of a sack, three passes defended and helped anchor a defense that is second in the NFL in total defense.
 - Second round pick LB Carson Schwesinger is leading the team with 79 tackles, while adding two interceptions and 1.5 sacks. He is leading all NFL rookies in tackles and is tied for the lead in interceptions. Schwesinger is the only NFL rookie to record multiple interceptions and sacks this season. His two interceptions are the most by a Browns rookie since CB Denzel Ward recorded three in 2018.
 - Second round pick RB Quinshon Judkins is leading the team with 620 rushing yards and five rushing scores. Earlier this year, he became the first Browns player ever to record at least 70 scrimmage yards in each of their first four career games. He is leading all NFL rookies in rushing yards and is tied for second in rushing touchdowns. Judkins' four runs of 30-plus yards are tied for third among all NFL players this season.
 - Third round pick TE Harold Fannin Jr. is leading the Browns with 44 receptions, the most by any Browns rookie in the first 11 weeks. He is fourth among all NFL rookies in receptions and fifth in receiving yards (396).
 - In six career starts, third round pick QB Dillon Gabriel has seven touchdown passes and two interceptions. He began his career with 121 passing attempts without throwing an interception until throwing his first in the third quarter at New England (10/26).
- CB Denzel Ward has recorded 31 tackles, one interception and six passes defended this season. He has 18 interceptions in his career and with one

more he will extend his streak of recording at least two interceptions every season since being drafted in the first round by the Browns in 2018. The four-time Pro Bowler has 101 career passes defended, the most by any player in the NFL since 2018. He is one of just three active players with at least 100 career passes defended.

- CB Tyson Campbell joined the Browns via trade prior to Week 6. In five games with the Browns, he has recorded 21 tackles, one interception (returned for a touchdown), five passes defended and one forced fumble. He is tied for fourth in the NFL this season with 11 passes defended.

- Last week, G Joel Bitonio appeared in and started his 171st career game, the 11th most on the Browns career games played list. His 171 career starts are the most by a Brown since the team returned in 1999. Bitonio has been selected to seven career Pro Bowls.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR THIS WEEK

TEAM

- The team has gone 38 straight games without allowing a 300-yard passer, the longest active streak in the NFL.

DE MYLES GARRETT

- One sack (16) from matching the franchise's single season record he set in 2021 and 2022.
- One sack from becoming third player in NFL history with three seasons with 16 sacks. JJ Watt and Reggie White have three.
- One tackle for loss from a career high for a single season. Had 22 in 2024.
- Can become the first player in NFL history with three games during a season with at least four sacks.
- His 117.5 sacks are the second most sacks by a player in their first nine seasons since 1982, trailing only Reggie White's 137.
- Needs a sack this week to become the fourth player since 1982 with 75 games with a sack in their first nine seasons, joining DeMarcus Ware (79), Reggie White (79) and Von Miller (77).

TE DAVID NJOKU

- 92 receiving yards away from the ninth most career receiving yards by a Brown. Would pass Brian Brennan (4,148).
- One touchdown breaks tie with Dante Lavelli (33) for the fifth most career receiving touchdowns by a Brown.

LB CARSON SCHWESINGER

- Aims for ninth game in a row with seven-or-more tackles.
- Nine tackles from the third most tackles by a Browns rookie in a season since the team moved back to Cleveland in 1999.

CB DENZEL WARD

- One game away with multiple pass deflections to pass Joe Haden (28) for most all-time by a Brown.
- Two interceptions from 20 career.

MY CAUSE MY CLEATS DESIGN

On Tuesday, Nov. 11, the Cleveland Browns and the Stay in the Game! Attendance Network hosted a school visit at Brooklyn School where students had the opportunity to help SITG! ambassador, DT Shelby Harris, customize his cleats as part of the NFL's annual My Cause My Cleats initiative. THE HEAD COACHES

BROWNS HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI



Head Coach Kevin Stefanski became the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history on January 13, 2020. In Stefanski's six years, the Browns are 42-52 (.447). The two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year led the Browns to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons, becoming the second coach in club history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins (Paul Brown, 1951 and 1953). In his first season, he led the club to their first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years, earning him his first AP Coach of the Year award. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski spent 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings in various roles. Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach, assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanski played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania, where he recorded 49 tackles, a forced fumble and one fumble recovery in 10 games played.

RAIDERS HEAD COACH PETE CARROLL



Pete Carroll was named the head coach of the Las Vegas Raiders on January 25, 2025. Carroll holds a career record of 172-128-1 (.573) as a head coach in the NFL, where he spent previous stints with the New York Jets (1994), New England Patriots (1997-99) and most recently the Seattle Seahawks (2010-2023), where he also served as the Executive Vice President of the team. During his tenure in Seattle, Carroll brought his team to the playoffs in 10

of his 14 seasons, including two Super Bowl appearances (2013-14) and one Championship (2013), defeating the Denver Broncos 43-8. Carroll manned one of the NFL's most feared defensive units, known as the 'Legion of Boom,' as well as helping guide quarterback Russell Wilson to eight Pro-Bowls. Carroll has also had coaching stints with the Buffalo Bills (1984), Minnesota Vikings (1985-89) and San Francisco 49ers (1995-96).







HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Stefanski has led the team to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons. He joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.
- Stefanski became the 16th coach to win the Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award multiple times since its inception in 1957. Stefanski won the honors in 2020 and 2023 and joined Forrest Gregg (1976) as the only Browns coaches to win the award.
- During the Browns 78-year history, the team has surpassed 6,000 scrimmage yards in a single season just seven times, but have reached the mark in four seasons under Stefanski. Since 2020, the Browns are fifth in the NFL with an average of 130.5 rushing yards per game.
- Stefanski has recorded a 28-17 (.622) record at Huntington Bank Field, while not recording a losing record at home in any season. The Browns finished 8-1 at home in 2023, a team record for wins at home.
- In his first season with the Browns, Stefanski led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years. He notched the most wins (11) by a first-year Browns head coach since Paul Brown had 12 in the team's inaugural season in 1946. Stefanski's 11 regular season wins were the most by a first-year head coach in 2020 and marked just the 11th time since 1970 a first-year coach has won 11 or more games. Stefanski was named the NFL Coach of the Year.

BUBBA VENTRONE | ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR

Ventrone brings 20 years of coaching and playing experience in the NFL with experience in two Super Bowls. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native joined the Browns ahead of the 2023 season and aided a special teams unit that set several franchise records including 33 made field goals and a 49.4-yard punt average and three blocked field goals. Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Ventrone spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts guiding the unit to a top-10 finish in his last three seasons. As an assistant special teams coach with the New England Patriots from 2015-17, he was a member of the Super Bowl LI winning team.



JIM SCHWARTZ | DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Schwartz is in his 17th season as an NFL defensive coordinator and his second with the Cleveland Browns. In his first season with the Browns, Schwartz won NFL Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the defense to several NFL-leading categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Schwartz was a defensive coordinator with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-20), winning Super Bowl LII, Buffalo Bills (2014) and Tennessee Titans (2001-08). The Baltimore, Md. native served as the head coach of the Detroit Lions from 2009-13, coaching the team to a 10-6 season in 2011 and a playoff berth for the first time since 1999.



TOMMY REES | OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Rees joined the Browns staff as tight ends/pass game specialist in 2024 and was hired as offensive coordinator in 2025. Rees spent the 2023 season as Alabama's offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach, helping the Crimson Tide win the SEC Championship Game and advance to the College Football Playoffs. Prior to Alabama, Rees spent six seasons as a coach at Notre Dame (2017-22), first coaching the quarterbacks and adding the role as offensive coordinator in 2020. In three years as Notre Dame's offensive coordinator, the team averaged more than 30 points per game each year and advanced to the College Football Playoffs in 2020 after posting an undefeated regular season.



CHAD O'SHEA | PASS GAME COORDINATOR/WIDE RECEIVERS

O'Shea joined the Browns in 2020 and is in his 22nd NFL season, winning 12 division titles, five conference championships and three Super Bowls (XLIX, LI and LIII). The Browns' offense saw Amari Cooper post back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in 2022, the first Brown to do so. In his first season, O'Shea aided the offense to 408 points, the second most in franchise history. Previously, the Houston, Texas native spent the 2019 season as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins and 2018-19 as the New England Patriots wide receivers coach.






