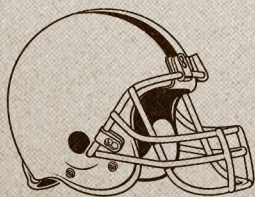

NOTABLE STORYLINES

- Last week, the Browns topped the Green Bay Packers, 13-10, at Huntington Bank Field. Trailing 10-0, the Browns scored all 13 of their points in the final 3:38, including a 55-yard game-winning field goal by K Andre Szmyt as time expired. The Browns defense limited the Packers to 230 net yards, while totaling five sacks. S Grant Delpit returned an interception 25 yards to the 4-yard line to set up the game tying touchdown. DT Shelby Harris blocked a 43-yard field goal attempt with 27 seconds remaining.
- The Browns defense leads the NFL this season in total defense (204.3 yards per game) and run defense (57.3 yards per game), while ranking fourth in pass defense (147.0 yards per game). Cleveland's defense hasn't allowed a team to gain more than 250 net yards in a single game this season. The Browns haven't allowed a 300-yard passer in 31 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the NFL.
- DE Myles Garrett is leading the NFL this season with seven tackles for loss and is tied for second with 4.0 sacks. He has recorded at least half of a sack in every game this season. Last season, Garrett led the NFL with 22 tackles for loss and finished second in the league with 14 sacks. Garrett also became the first player in NFL history to record at least 14 sacks in four consecutive seasons (2021-24). He joined Hall of Famer Lawrence Taylor as the only NFL players to record at least 12 sacks in five consecutive seasons (2020-24). Garrett is the only NFL player to record at least 10 sacks in each of the past seven seasons (2018-24).
- Rookie TE Harold Fannin Jr. is leading the Browns and all NFL rookies with 15 receptions this season. His 15 receptions are the third-most by an NFL rookie TE in the first three weeks of a season. They are also the most by any Browns rookie in the first three weeks.
- Last week, rookie RB Quinshon Judkins rushed for 94 yards and scored his first NFL touchdown on a 1-yard run in the fourth quarter. Despite only playing in two games this year, Judkins is leading the Browns and all NFL rookies this season with 155 rushing yards. His two rushes of 30-plus yards are tied for the second-most in the NFL this season.
- Rookie LB Carson Schwesinger tied for the team lead with nine tackles last week, while adding his first career sack. On the season, he is tied for second among all NFL rookies with 21 tackles.
- This offseason, the Browns signed QB Joe Flacco, who spent a portion of the 2023 season with the club. That season, Flacco went 4-1 as a starter, while becoming the first player in Browns history to throw for 300 yards in four consecutive games en route to being named the NFL Comeback Player of the Year. He owns a 106-88 (.556) career record as a starter, including a 5-3 (.625) mark with the Browns.
- The Browns voted five season-long captains for the 2025 season. G Joel Bitonio and QB Joe Flacco were selected from the offense, DE Myles Garrett and CB Denzel Ward from the defense and P Corey Bojorquez from special teams. Three of the five captains served in the role during the 2024 season, with Bojorquez and Flacco stepping into the new role for the 2025 season.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR THIS WEEK

TEAM

- The team has gone 31 straight games without allowing a 300-yard passer, the longest active streak in the NFL.

DE MYLES GARRETT

- 1.5 sacks pass Derrick Thomas (107.5) for fifth most sacks by a player in their first nine seasons.
- With two sacks can surpass Reggie White (108) for the most sacks by a player under the age of 30.
- Two sacks tie himself for the most sacks (6) by a Brown through the first four games of a season. One ties himself (2020) and Jamir Miller (2001) for fourth most in 2020 and 1.5 ties his 2023 season.

QB JOE FLACCO

- 200th career game.

TE DAVID NJOKU

- 23 receiving yards away from entering the top 10 in most career receiving yards by a Brown. Will pass Dante Lavelli (3,908).
- 114 receiving yards away from 4,000 career.
- Two touchdowns tie Reggie Rucker (32) for the sixth most career receiving touchdowns by a Brown.

CB DENZEL WARD

- Three pass deflections from 100 career.
- One game away with multiple pass deflections to match Joe Haden (28) for most all-time by a Brown.

TE HAROLD FANNIN JR.

- Seven receptions tie Sam LaPorta (22) for the most by an NFL rookie TE through the first four games of a season. Six ties Keith Jackson for second and five ties Brock Bowers for third.

BROWNS GIVE BACK

The Browns have a unified and focused philanthropic mission with "Browns Give Back" that extends throughout Northeast Ohio. Led by Dee and Jimmy Haslam, Whitney and JW Johnson, David Jenkins, Andrew Berry and Kevin Stefanski, the entire Browns organization - coaches, players and front office members - are dedicated to creating meaningful impact in the communities in which we live and work by investing their time and resources under the Browns Give Back platform.

The target of these endeavors devotes to three focus areas: **EDUCATION**, **YOUTH FOOTBALL** and **EQUITABLE OPPORTUNITIES** across Northeast Ohio and beyond.

ALUMNI PRACTICE

As part of Alumni Weekend, the Browns welcomed former players to a special team practice back in Cleveland on Sept. 20. More than 80 alumni attended, including 25 members of the 1985 team. Players reconnected with old teammates and engaged with the current team, just before the Browns matchup against the Packers.



HIGH SCHOOL GAME OF THE WEEK

Willoughby South High School defeated Maple Heights High School 7-6 at Harry E. Winters Stadium on Sept. 19. Willoughby South head coach Matt Duffy earned the Coach of the Week title, while Cane Balash was named the game's MVP. Duffy has been Willoughby South's coach for 17 years, and is the school's all-time leading football coach in wins. The Rebels remain undefeated at home and enter next week's matchup with a 3-2 record after the win on Friday.

He also led a gym session filled with fun games, encouraging teamwork and school spirit. To cap off the day, Chomps shared lunch with the students, creating memorable moments for all the students in school.



THE HEAD COACHES

BROWNS HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI



Head Coach Kevin Stefanski became the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history on January 13, 2020. In Stefanski's six years, the Browns are 41-46 (.471). The two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year led the Browns to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons, becoming the second coach in club history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins (Paul Brown, 1951 and 1953). In his first season, he led the club to their first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years, earning him his first AP Coach of the Year award. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski spent 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings in various roles. Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach, assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanski played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania, where he recorded 49 tackles, a forced fumble and one fumble recovery in 10 games played.

LIONS HEAD COACH DAN CAMPBELL



Dan Campbell was named the head coach of the Detroit Lions on Jan. 20, 2021. Since his arrival, Campbell has guided the Lions to the postseason twice, including their first NFC North division title in 30 years and the team's first playoff victory since 1991. Last season, his club recorded the most victories (15), points scored (564) and touchdowns scored (70) in a single season in franchise history, as well as securing the number one overall seed in the NFC for the first time ever. In 2023, the Lions were victorious in two postseason games, making Campbell the third Lions' head coach to win multiple playoff games (George Wilson [1957] and Buddy Parker [1953]). Before returning to Detroit, Campbell held coaching stints in New Orleans (2016-20) and Miami (2015), as well as an 11-year playing career with the Giants (1999-2002), Cowboys (2003-05), Lions (2006-08) and Saints (2009).

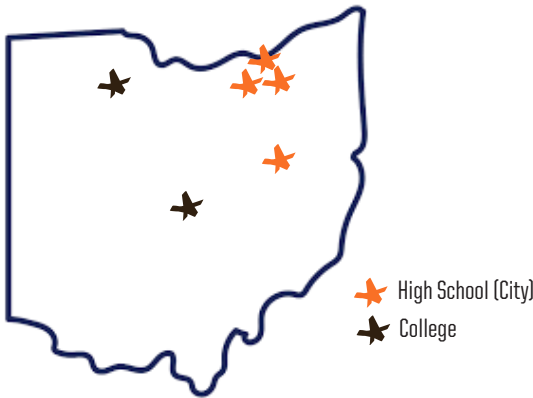

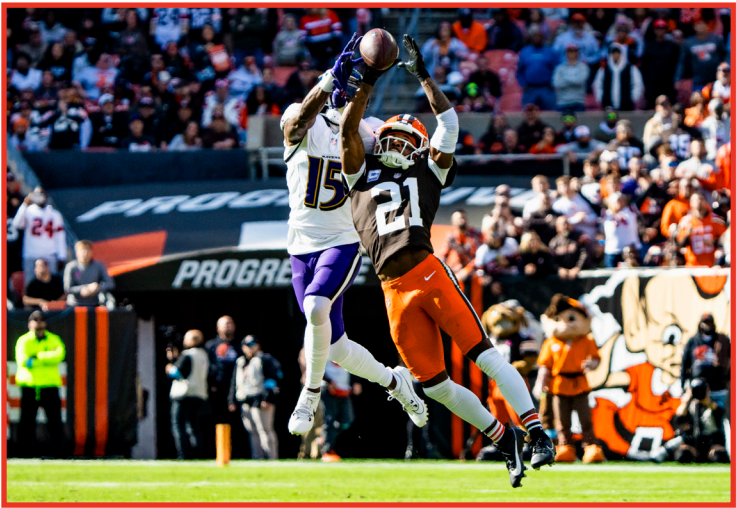

HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Stefanski has led the team to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons. He joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.
- Stefanski became the 16th coach to win the Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award multiple times since its inception in 1957. Stefanski won the honors in 2020 and 2023 and joined Forrest Gregg (1976) as the only Browns coaches to win the award.
- During the Browns 78-year history, the team has surpassed 6,000 scrimmage yards in a single season just seven times, but have reached the mark in four seasons under Stefanski. Since 2020, the Browns are fifth in the NFL with an average of 130.5 rushing yards per game.
- Stefanski has recorded a 27-17 (.613) record at Huntington Bank Field, while not recording a losing record at home in any season. The Browns finished 8-1 at home in 2023, a team record for wins at home.
- In his first season with the Browns, Stefanski led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years. He notched the most wins (11) by a first-year Browns head coach since Paul Brown had 12 in the team's inaugural season in 1946. Stefanski's 11 regular season wins were the most by a first-year head coach in 2020 and marked just the 11th time since 1970 a first-year coach has won 11 or more games. Stefanski was named the NFL Coach of the Year.

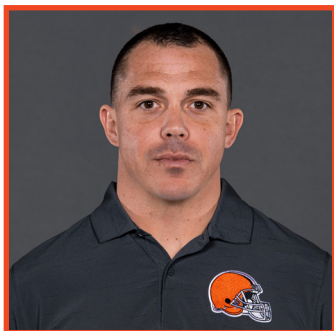

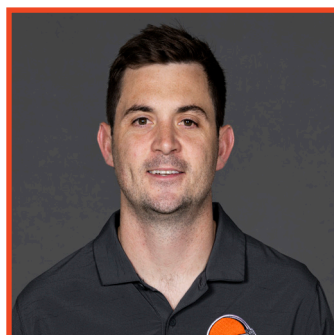
BUBBA VENTRONE | ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR

Ventrone brings 20 years of coaching and playing experience in the NFL with experience in two Super Bowls. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native joined the Browns ahead of the 2023 season and aided a special teams unit that set several franchise records including 33 made field goals and a 49.4-yard punt average and three blocked field goals. Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Ventrone spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts guiding the unit to a top-10 finish in his last three seasons. As an assistant special teams coach with the New England Patriots from 2015-17, he was a member of the Super Bowl LI winning team.



JIM SCHWARTZ | DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Schwartz is in his 17th season as an NFL defensive coordinator and his second with the Cleveland Browns. In his first season with the Browns, Schwartz won NFL Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the defense to several NFL-leading categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Schwartz was a defensive coordinator with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-20), winning Super Bowl LII, Buffalo Bills (2014) and Tennessee Titans (2001-08). The Baltimore, Md. native served as the head coach of the Detroit Lions from 2009-13, coaching the team to a 10-6 season in 2011 and a playoff berth for the first time since 1999.



TOMMY REES | OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

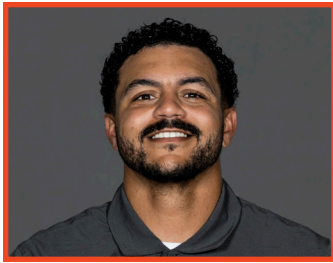
Rees joined the Browns staff as tight ends/pass game specialist in 2024 and was hired as offensive coordinator in 2025. Rees spent the 2023 season as Alabama's offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach, helping the Crimson Tide win the SEC Championship Game and advance to the College Football Playoffs. Prior to Alabama, Rees spent six seasons as a coach at Notre Dame (2017-22), first coaching the quarterbacks and adding the role as offensive coordinator in 2020. In three years as Notre Dame's offensive coordinator, the team averaged more than 30 points per game each year and advanced to the College Football Playoffs in 2020 after posting an undefeated regular season.



CHAD O'SHEA | PASS GAME COORDINATOR/WIDE RECEIVERS

O'Shea joined the Browns in 2020 and is in his 22nd NFL season, winning 12 division titles, five conference championships and three Super Bowls (XLIX, LI and LIII). The Browns' offense saw Amari Cooper post back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in 2022, the first Brown to do so. In his first season, O'Shea aided the offense to 408 points, the second most in franchise history. Previously, the Houston, Texas native spent the 2019 season as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins and 2018-19 as the New England Patriots wide receivers coach.

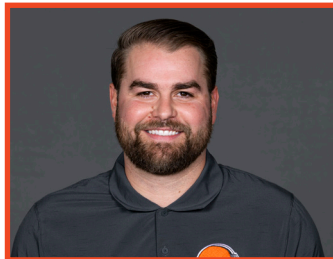

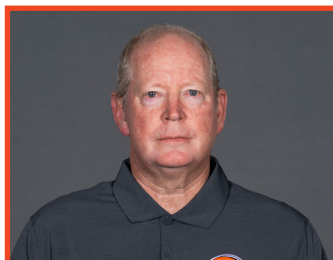

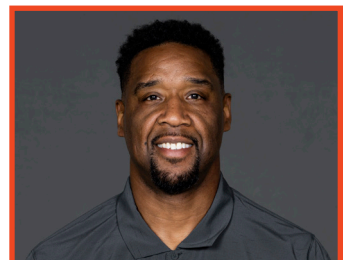
