- Rookie RB Quinshon Judkins rushed for 82 yards and one touchdown, while adding four receptions for 33 yards. He has surpassed 100 scrimmage yards with a touchdown in each of the past two games. Judkins is leading the team this season with 237 rushing yards and two rushing touchdowns.

CB Denzel Ward

- CB Denzel Ward recorded two tackles, one interception and one pass defended. It was his first interception of the season and 18th of his career. He also has 98 career passes defended.
